Building Fund Appeal L. 1953 realised £850

- St Thomas School Church Opened Nov 15<sup>th</sup> 1953 by Archbishop Mannix Midnight Mass at Christmas 1953 1954
- 1954 Jan 16<sup>th</sup>
   Blackburn became a parish
   Father Paul Ryan has PP his first Parish
- Feb 2<sup>nd</sup> 1954
   School of St Thomas the Apostle opened with 50 foundation pupils
- Dec 1954
   Presbytery blessed & and opened by Dean Simmonds
