 Advice that an indication of our intention to submit a proposal for extensions to the Schwerkoll Cottage and Museum Complex be sent to City of Whitehorse soon in time for it to receive attention in Council's 2000 program and budget. Moved B Keene, seconded B Reynolds that a letter be sent to the CEO foreshadowing a request for consideration of extension proposals. their interest in participating in this nomination.

* A Jones moved, seconded by J Barnes, that a letter be sent to to City of Whitehorse, seeking information about the stage of progress of the feasibility study of Strathdon Orchard, indicating our interest in the site on account of its cultural importance to the area and our wish to be consulted in the course of the study.
