DRAFT DISCUSSION PAPER FOR NDHS COMMITTEE

NUNAWADING & DISTRICT HISTORICAL SOCIETY STREET NAMES PROJECT

The Society commenced a project in 1999 (7) to collect and record the origin of street names within the former City of Numawading, which would complement "The Origins of Box Hill Steet Names", by Charles F. Williams, published by the City of Box Hill in 1985. This project has lost momentum in recent times, and it is proposed that it be resumed. The NDHS Committee is requested to consider the following matters, considered necessary to provide a guide to the resumption of the Project:

1 Database to be created to contain the information elements:

- Street Name/Suhirh/Melways Reference/Origin of Name/Source of Reference.
- Origin of name to contain, where available:
 Person/Family/Organisation responsible, their status, occupation, associations
 Date of first use of name
 Subdivision/Estate name
 Former names
- Source of Reference to contain, where available:
 Name of informant or Anon, including contact details
 Publication/Archive reference
 "Street Name File" reference no, for all documents received
- · Other?

Questions

- Is there an existing usable database?
- Do we want facilities other than straight listing? (Eg do we want a cross-referencing facility which would answer the query. "which streets was Developer X responsible for naming?")
- For how long was the NDHS Newsletter supplement query form issued?
- Do we want Ward information?
- Are there directly accessible Council records available?
- What verification criteria should be applied before accepting information? (Eg where
 existing information has been supplied anonymously, and no follow-up or
 independent verification is possible?)

3. Proposed methodology

- Establish database using data already supplied, adding to it as further data is obtained
- Publicise resumption of project through Newsletter, Whitehorse News and local papers. Include contact phone, address of Society (and on-ordinator's and other emails?) for responses
- Resume Newsletter supplement, in alphabetical sections (will take 8 years, at previous rate of progress)
- Request regular space in Whitehorse News, local papers for street lists
- Place message in Heritage Network Project database.
- Request local schools to encourage student projects in targeted areas; contact Deakin University to see if assistance available
- Identify other potential sources of information and request co-operation, eg City of Whitehorse, local real estate agents.
- Scrutinise recent oral history interviews
- Construct response form for phone and other oral information, to facilitate questioning in desired areas of information, as above
- Seek project grant to speed information gathering, information processing and publication of results (known community interest)
