GENERAL BUSINESS:

George Demetrious had previously asked permission to speak to Committee on bluestone kerbs in Vernal Avenue. Street reconstruction taking place and he is concerned that Council does not always reconstruct kerbs in same fashion. Council has gone back on its undertaking to maintain bluestone kerbs in Vernal Avenue because they claim they don't have enough bluestone. Council Kaele Way has requested that Society write a letter in support of bluestone kerb maintenance. Judith Fry moved and Barbara Gardiner seconded that a letter be sent to Council objecting to their disregard of heritage value of bluestone kerbing in Vernal Avenue and requesting that Council begin a policy for protection of remaining bluestone kerbs similar to that of Hobson Bay Council. Carried.

Secretary asked to write a letter to Tony Maher of Whitehorse Film Society asking about possibility of obtaining a copy of 1970 film on City of Nunawading as shown to our Society last year.
