# LOCAL HISTORY ROOM, SCHWERKOLT COTTAGE AND MUSEUM COMPLEX

### Welcome

Special item: Allison Egan of City of Whitehorse was in attendance to discuss the latest Landscape Concept plans with the Committee, as more members are present than on the next Working Group day. Among the points she made are:

Comments are after discussion with VicRoads; much of the content is still conceptual, and some details do not relate to contracts let; dark green areas refer to "full vegeatation, mulched bushland" - Legend is confusing; VicRoads intend to plant less of a "monoculture" than in other areas; Whitehorse has asked that species which could crosspollinate with natural species not be used; proposed "sound tubes" in several places to reduce height impact of noise walls; some gaps in noise walls (Option B path area will be closed); existing windbreaks will be retained, with some augmentation of vegetation; some artificial treatments on steep areas of cuttings as necessary. Copy of Whitehorse submission left for reference by Society members. Reminder that Cr. K Way is a representative on Consultative Committee, with Kelvin Ward from Council, and they can bring up issues at the Committee if required. VicRoads have indicated that they will prepare a Management Plan for the area between the two portals in the next twelve months, although the precise geographic area has not been defined.
