Usually made of a lightweightwood such as pine or boxwood

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

Purchase of plastic enclosures (polybags)

These are used principally for the protection of documents - books and pamphlets, maps, newspaper cuttings and other documents. They are also used occasionally for protection of artifacts. We have no stocks left, except for bags which are slightly too big for filing cabinets - they can be caught when opening and closing the cabinets. Most maps are either unprotected or in bags combined with sticky tape. Their adhesive is aggressive, leaves deposits and stains the articles.

Purchase of three sizes is recommended:

22 x 35 cm (small documents, books and pamphlets up to A4)

55 x 65 and 80 x 110 cm (maps and plans)

Quotation for supply in the three sizes is \$150, \$328 and \$730 per thousand respectively; unfortunately, minimum quantity is 1000! Total cost is \$1208.00.

The Committee is requested to authorise this purchase.
