Hi All,

I hope this finds you all healthy and well and looking forward to Term 2, albeit in a very different format! A number of staff have indicated they would like to come on site to collect belongings or items they require for teaching at home. <u>Please contact David Simmelmann in advance of the day on which you</u> would like to come in.

Please note the following process for all staff, parents and students attending campus, and visitors/contractors when coming on to the College grounds:

- 1. Access for families with children attending Creche or ELC is via Tooronga Road only.
- 2. Access for visitors (including staff not working on-site see above re: notification process) or contractors access is <u>via Auburn Road only</u>.
- 3. All staff, students and visitors will need to have a temperature check (via hand held device that doesn't touch your skin), use a sanitiser at the guard booth and complete a declaration they are well / haven't travelled overseas / exposed to anyone with COVID-19 before entering the campus.
- 4. <u>For ALL staff working on site, parking is in the Sports Centre car park only</u>, after which they must proceed to the Tooronga Road guard when arriving to complete the above mentioned temperature and declaration checks.

Anyone who has a temperature of 38C or above, is showing signs of being unwell, or answers any COVID-19 questions affirmatively, will not be permitted on campus.
