## **Dear Parents**

We would like to update you regarding our plans for Purim this year. We are excited to be able to run a full provision that will be a truly memorable moment in our students' lives and education. We do however, need to inform you of a few changes from the previous email you would have received.

- Unfortunately our Year 12 students will not be able to visit Dandenong West Primary School as they are not permitting external visitors at this point in time. Our students will still have an incredibly rewarding program on campus. Attendance remains compulsory.
- 2. We are not able to invite all of our parent body on campus this year. We will instead be inviting parents of children from Creche Year 1 for their parades on the courts outside the Sports Centre, and ONE parent per Year 12 student for the costume parade in the Amphitheatre from 9.00am to 9.30am. Unfortunately we are not able

to welcome any other parents on campus at this time, other than those BCPA volunteers who have already registered with Sally Robin.

This includes the wearing of masks at all times, social distancing and staying within designated areas, as per maps that will be provided upon entry.
- 4. All parents and external visitors who attend campus on this day, including those parents dropping students at the gate or ELC, MUST sign in with the QR code posters that will be present.
