"For 54 years I have in various positions ever striven to achieve two great objects; firstly, to hold the British Empire together, and to secure to it the power of a just expansion; secondly, I have ever strove to preserve Australia and the islands in the Pacific for some English race, all Europeans to be permitted to occupy those vast territories on equal terms. They were to be governed by themselves, and to receive a free education in public schools in which the English language was taught. America, Great Britain and her dependencies, could under such circumstances, enter into one great federation, powerful, and peace giving to all mankind"
