**Peter
Walmsley**

Musical Director of the Willoughby Municipal Band since 1970, Peter Walmsley is a member of the Trumpet section of the Sydney Symphony Orchestra. He commenced his musical career under his father, Harold Walmsley, a well-known brass band conductor, and adjudicated and also studied piano with Lance Dossor at the Elder Conservatorium of Music, Adelaide.

Successes in brass solo competitions have been many, Mr Walmsley having won over 40 on tenor horn, Bb cornet and soprano cornet, including the Australian Open Champion of Champions at the age of 15. He was instrumental winner of the ABC's Concerto competition in South Australia and also a Commonwealth finalist.

Currently Mr Walmsley is also Musical Director of the Band at Barker College and adjudicates extensively throughout Australia. At present he is researching material for a book on "Brass Bands in Australia" to be published next year by Oxford University Press.



**Glenn
Madden**

One of Australia's most brilliant trumpet players, Glenn Madden has been a member of the Adelaide Symphony Orchestra since 1966 and has recently been appointed Principal Trumpet of the A.S.O.

Born in Tasmania, he had his first experience as an orchestral soloist in ABC Instrumental and Vocal Competitions, appearing in four State and two National Finals.

His solo appearances with the Adelaide Symphony Orchestra have ranged from country tours to a packed Adelaide Town Hall Prom concert series. He has also acted as Principal Trumpet in the Sydney Symphony Orchestra and has played solo posthorn with the Sydney Symphony Orchestra under Willem van Otterloo.

In 1979 Glenn Madden spent a year in an overseas exchange posting with the Malme Symphony Orchestra in Sweden. He took the opportunity to have private lessons from several internationally celebrated trumpet players.

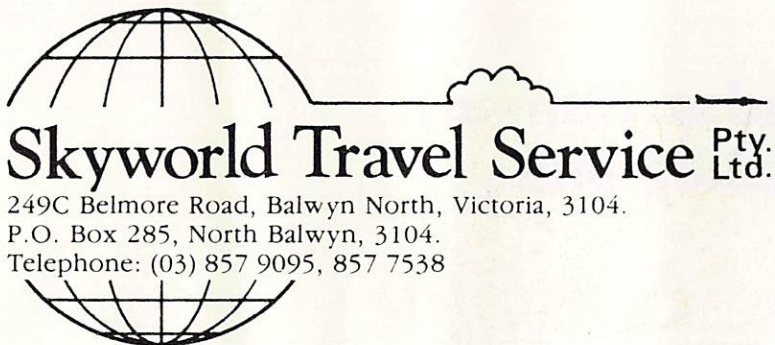
He is Musical Director of the Elizabeth City Brass Band who were "B" Grade Champions of Victoria and South Australia in 1981 and 1982. They have now been promoted to "A" Grade.

Latham**

Christopher Latham was born in England in 1935 and was educated in Worcester Royal Grammar School, Birmingham School of Music, and the Royal Academy of Music, London, where he graduated in 1958 with a degree in music teaching. He then held posts in three small co-educational boarding schools in the South of England before taking up his present position of Director of Music at Scotch College Melbourne in 1978. He is now living in East Doncaster and has recently become an Australian citizen.

He is on the panel of examiners for the A.M.E.B. and adjudicated the Concert Band Section at Royal South Street, 1982, and more recently was Chief Adjudicator for the 1983 Victorian Solo & Party Championships.

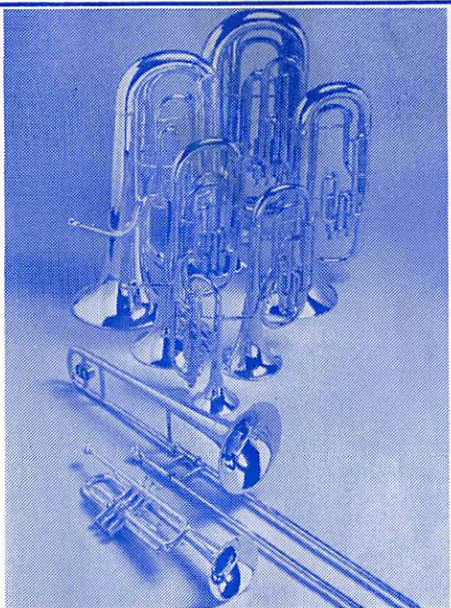

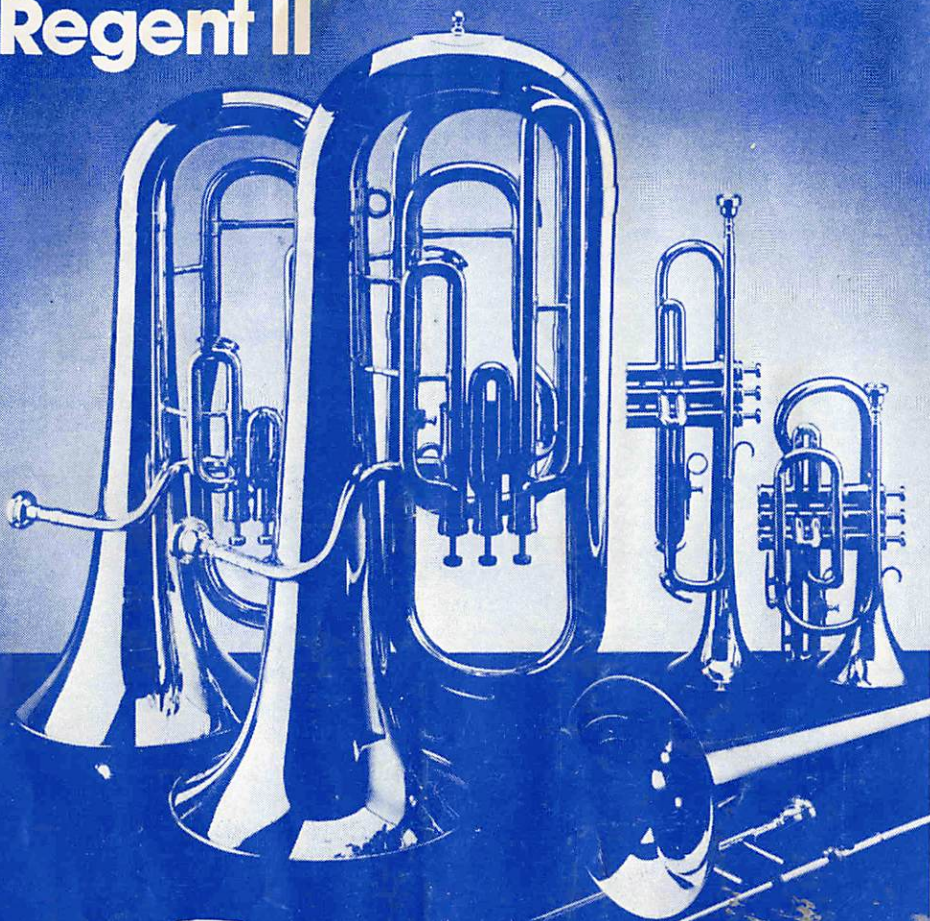
