INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

WRITTEN SECTION:—Examination books and blotting paper will be issued to each candidate; pens, pencils, rubbers, rulers and ink are to be supplied by the candidate, but no other materials are to be brought into the examination room. Candidates should read the instructions printed on the examination book. Any candidate copying or assisting another renders herself liable to disqualification. Time will be given for candidates to read the question paper. Following the signal to commence writing, the information on the front of the book should be filled in before answering any questions. A separate page should be used for each question, but not for each division of a question. On the top right-hand corner of each page, the candidate should write the number and division of the question answered on that page. The number of books used should be noted on the outside cover of each book. All writing is to be done in the books supplied — rough work if any is to be done on the unruled pages.

Should you require paper or wish to speak to the Examination Supervisor, stand up in your place.

A warning signal will be given 5 minutes before the close of the examination and a final signal to cease writing at the end of the appointed time. No writing of any description (including numbering of questions etc.) is permitted after the final signal. Candidates should remain seated until all books are collected.

PRACTICAL SECTION:—Candidates should take the examination card to both sections of the examination and wear it at the practical examination. The procedure book should be taken to the practical examination.

DO NOT DETACH
