JOHN G. SULLIVAN
18.2.1918-2.8.1997

John was born in Moreland, received his secondary education at Northcote High School and subsequently obtained a Bachelor of Commerce degree at Melbourne University. He was employed with the State Electricity Commission for 44 years in senior administration and personnel positions, interrupted by 3½ years of war service with the RAAF as a navigator (Flight Lieutenant) with Beaufort Squadrons. Over the years he actively participated in cricket, field umpiring with the Victorian Amateur Football Association for ten years and playing tennis. John also actively participated in Freemasonry for many years, was appointed Grand Lecturer 1974/78, attained the rank of Past Deputy Grand Master 1985 and was the author of two books on Freemasonry. Among other achievements were a DVA Story Telling and Poetry Competition award and he was a cryptic crossword fan. He was at one stage Chairman of East Kew Central School Committee, was a member of the Naval and Military Club, the RSL, Friends of the Fort, Queenscliff and Cottage by the Sea, Queenscliff.

John joined Melbourne Legacy 1983 (proposed by the late President Legatee Morrie Tonkin) and was himself Melbourne Legacy President 1991 after having been Chairman of Kew/North Melbourne Branch 1986, Chairman of Badge Appeal Committee 1986/87, Deputy Chairman, Administration Committee 1988, Chairman of Widows' Committee and Widows' Accommodation Task Group 1989/90.

John experienced the sadness of the deaths of wife Peg (1942/81) and their two sons and is survived by his daughter and seven grandchildren. He married Jane Holder (daughter of Legatee Morrie Tonkin) in 1982 and became the step-father of Jane's four children and step-grandfather of their 13 children.
