He joined Shell Australia in 1957 and in the ensuing 35 years held a number of senior finance and general management positions. He was Finance Controller of the Shell Group of Companies from 1982 until his retirement in 1993. He is a past Chairman of the Australian Accounting Standards Board.

Graeme served for 35 years as a CMF/Army Reserve Officer and following three years as Commanding Officer of 10 Medium Regiment he was appointed Commanding Officer of Monash University Regiment. In 1986 he was promoted to Brigadier and appointed Commander of the Third Training Group.

He was made a Member of the Order of Australia in 1988. He is a Past President of the Naval and Military Club (where he will be inducted on Sunday 16th March at the Change over Luncheon).

Graeme is a past Honorary Colonel of the Monash University Regiment, past Colonel Commandant of the Royal Regiment of Australian Artillery and a past Trustee of the War Veterans Homes Trust of Victoria. Interests include Lawn Bowls and he is a current member of the Victorian State Emergency Service. He has five adult children and eleven grandchildren.
