THE FINAL MATCH.

TARNAGULLA WINS THE CUP.

TARNAGULLA V. LLANELLY.

Having won the minor premiership, Tarnagulla was challenged by Llanelly, who were runners up, to a final match. This was to be extended over two days, and the game was played on the New-bridge ground. Great interest was taken in the match, and there was a good gathering present. The match was commenced last Saturday week, and on the drawing of the stumps on that day the Tarnagulla club held a leading position, Llanelly having been disposed of for 71, and Tarnagulla had scored 81 for the loss of only four wickets. The two not out men, Martin and Gourlay, resumed their places at the crease and commenced to score very freely, 50 being added in half an hour. White then tried underhand tobs, and was successful in having both batsmen caught, Martin having made 30, and Gourlay 36. None of the others reached double figures, and the innings closed for 150. The Llanelly team had 79 to make to save a one-innings defeat, but the first batsman, White and Hurford started off at a great pace and knocked up 47 before a separation was effected. At this stage J. Rogers, who was fielding as substitute, caught them both close on the boundary. Wilson and W. Chamberlain next faced the bowling, and the fourth wicket fell when the score stood at 87, the latter scoring 25, and the former 15. A Chamberlain also scored 15 not out, and with only three-quarters of an hour to go the innings was closed, seven being out for 115. This left the Tarnagulla team only 40 to make to win, which was accomplished with the loss of only two wickets.

The match was played in a good spirit all through. Tarnagulla have gone through the competition with only one defeat, and Llanelly also had only a single defeat, but had more unfinished games against them. By winning this match the Tarnagulla team win Mr Butcher's handsome silver cup, and are to be congratulated on their success.
