TO MR. WALTER HENRY PRESTON'S SHALI CUP, KNIGHT ALFRED TINDALL  
(Administrator called "the Donor") SUMS CONTAINING

THE DAB the Donor being anxious of encouraging the best  
contesting in Victorian waters has donated a Cup being the Cup  
to be possessed of the Royal Brighton Yacht Club. (BECOMING  
known as the Donor) which association shall nominate one  
other called "the Donee" which association shall nominate one  
Cup to be used in its stead either for the time being or subsequently  
to be called for annually in friendly competition AND THAT  
the power is conferred of declaring the conditions on which such  
cup shall hereafter be held NOT LESS THAN TWELVE ONE THREE ONE  
TUESDAY EVENING IN MAY ONE THREE ONE  
LONDONERS nominated to be held on the following occasions  
2/69 RE NAMED FOR EARL FARNHAM MEMORIAL CUP  
A. The Cup shall be called "THE FARNHAM CUP".

B. To shall be preserved as a perpetual trophy for annual  
7/2/67 SELLING  
competition between the International Star Class of the Royal

Brighton Yacht Club 1900 or such other class of Victorian Yachts  
as my exec time to time be determined in the manner hereinafter  
provided with respect to the alteration of any of the conditions  
of this Document.

3. The trustees of the Cup shall be the flag officers of the  
Club being of the Donee and the property in the Cup shall be  
vested in such trustees but the possession of the Cup shall  
time to time be held by the Yacht winning the Cup in the annual  
competitions last held until it shall be won by another Yacht and shall  
shall be held subject to such conditions for its use as  
my exec time to time be deemed proper by the flag officers for  
the time being of the Donee.

4. Competitors shall be held annually in the home waters of the  
Donee and shall be open to International Star Class Yachts or  
the Royal Brighton Yacht Club 1900 (and the form of other class  
for less time and week before the date fixed for the race to be  
conferred to the Royal Yacht Club. Such form of entry shall  
state the name of the Yacht or Yachts and the name of the owner

On owners of each yacht and a copy of the Certificate of Insurance  
of each yacht shall be required by the Dunces accompany such  
form of entry.

5. The contests in each year shall be under the control and

management of the Dunces which may at its option do-~~or~~-the con-  
tacts of the Brighton Fleet Committee or the International Star

Class. The Dunces shall appoint a Sailing Committee which shall  
have all the powers of a Sailing Committee under the rules of the  
International Star Class as laid down in the Log Book. The  
competitions shall take place each year between the First of January  
and the Thirtieth of March.

6. The Cup shall be competed for in a series of three consecutive  
three races arranged by the Dunces which may at its option do-~~or~~-  
the services of the Brighton Fleet Committee or the International

Star Class and points in each race shall be allotted on the basis  
of 9 points for the first yacht, 5 points for the second yacht,  
3 points for the third yacht and 1 point for each yacht that comes  
shorter to the course. The yacht which has the greatest number of

points standing to its credit at the conclusion of the third race  
shall be declared the winner. In the event of 3 or more yachts  
having an equal number of points standing to their respective

credit, at the conclusion of the three races heretofore named,  
selected such yachts only shall sail a further race under the same  
rules and conditions as herein laid down subject to the proviso

that the yacht which finishes first in such further race shall be  
declared the winner. The races shall be held in the home  
waters of the Dunces over a distance to be determined by the Dunces  
and the crew of each yacht shall be members of the Dunces.

7. No protest shall be valid unless lodged with the sailing  
committee controlling the contest within forty-eight hours after  
the completion of the race in which the subject matter of the  
protest shall have occurred. A protest shall be considered by  
the sailing committee and its decision shall be final except

that an appeal from such decision shall lie on matters other than

of fact to the Victorian Yachting Council.

8. For the purposes of "the Franklin Cup", each and every International Star Class yacht must in every way conform to the plans, specifications and rules of the International Star Class.

9. All or any of the conditions of this Deed may from time to time be altered and further conditions may be added hereto

provided that so long as the Donor is resident in the Commonwealth of Australia no such alterations or additions shall be made without his sanction. Any alteration or addition shall be recorded by endorsement or annexure to this Deed signed by the Flag Officers for the time being of the Donor.
