- 1. THE TRUSTEES OF THE CUP SHALL BE THE FLAG OFFICERS OF THE ROYAL

 BRIGHTON YACHT CLUB FOR THE TIME BEING AND THE PROPERTY IN THE CUP

 SHALL BE VESTED IN SUCH TRUSTEES; BUT THE POSSESSION OF THE CUP SHALL

 FROM YEAR TO YEAR BE HELD BY THE CLUB CHAMPION AS DECIDED IN CONTEST.
- 2. THE CUP SHALL BE COMPETED FOR ANNUALLY AT SUCH TIME OF EACH YEAR
 AS THE TRUSTEES DECREE PREFERABLY DURING THE MONTHS MAY TO
 SEPTEMBER.
- 3. THE TRUSTEES SHALL APPOINT A DESIGNATED PERSON OR SELECT COMMITTEE NOT EXCEEDING THREE PEOPLE TO IMPLEMENT THE ORGANISATION AND THE RUNNING OF THE EVENT.
- 4. THE CHAMPIONSHIP SHALL BE OPEN TO JUNIOR AND SENIOR MEMBERS OF THE ROYAL BRIGHTON YACHT CLUB.
- 5. NO ENTRY TO THE COMPETITION WILL BE ACCEPTED FROM ANY MEMBER OF THE CLUB WHO IS PLAYING THE GAME OF SQUASH AS A PROFESSIONAL OR WHO DERIVES AN INCOME FROM THE TEACHING OF THE GAME OF SQUASH.
- 6. THE CLUB CHAMPION SHALL BE DECIDED IN OPEN COMPETITION, PLAYING HANDICAPS TO ALL OR ANY ENTRANT SHALL NOT BE ALLOTTED.
