GENTLEMEN,

PURSUANT TO THE COMPLETION OF THE EXTENSIONS TO THE CLUB HOUSE DURING 1962 INCORPORATING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SQUASH COURT THEREIN AND IN ORDER TO ENCOURAGE THE PROMOTION OF SQUASH WITHIN THE CLUB IT IS THE PLEASURE OF THE UNDERSIGNED TO DONATE A PERPETUAL TROPHY FOR A CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP EVENT UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS :-


1. THE TRUSTEES OF THE CUP SHALL BE THE FLAG OFFICERS OF THE ROYAL BRIGHTON YACHT CLUB FOR THE TIME BEING AND THE PROPERTY IN THE CUP SHALL BE VESTED IN SUCH TRUSTEES; BUT THE POSSESSION OF THE CUP SHALL FROM YEAR TO YEAR BE HELD BY THE CLUB CHAMPION AS DECIDED IN CONTEST.
2. THE CUP SHALL BE COMPETED FOR ANNUALLY AT SUCH TIME OF EACH YEAR AS THE TRUSTEES DECREE PREFERABLY DURING THE MONTHS MAY TO SEPTEMBER.
3. THE TRUSTEES SHALL APPOINT A DESIGNATED PERSON OR SELECT COMMITTEE NOT EXCEEDING THREE PEOPLE TO IMPLEMENT THE ORGANISATION AND THE RUNNING OF THE EVENT.
4. THE CHAMPIONSHIP SHALL BE OPEN TO JUNIOR AND SENIOR MEMBERS OF THE ROYAL BRIGHTON YACHT CLUB.
5. NO ENTRY TO THE COMPETITION WILL BE ACCEPTED FROM ANY MEMBER OF THE CLUB WHO IS PLAYING THE GAME OF SQUASH AS A PROFESSIONAL OR WHO DERIVES AN INCOME FROM THE TEACHING OF THE GAME OF SQUASH.
6. THE CLUB CHAMPION SHALL BE DECIDED IN OPEN COMPETITION, PLAYING HANDICAPS TO ALL OR ANY ENTRANT SHALL NOT BE ALLOTTED.
7. THE COMPETITION SHALL BE PLAYED ON A KNOCK OUT BASIS AND PLAYED UNDER THE RULES CURRENTLY IN EXISTENCE AND AS ISSUED BY THE SQUASH RACKETS ASSOCIATION OF VICTORIA.

8. IN THE EVENT OF ANY DISPUTE ARISING REGARDING PLAYING RULES, SUCH DISPUTE IS TO BE REFERRED TO THE APPROPRIATE COMMITTEE OF THE SQUASH RACKETS ASSOCIATION OF VICTORIA WHOSE DECISION SHALL BE FINAL AND BINDING.

9. ALL OR ANY OF THESE CONDITIONS WITH THE EXCEPTION OF CLAUSE (6) SIX MAY BE ALTERED OR ADDED TO BY THE TRUSTEES SHOULD CIRCUMSTANCES WARRANT PROVIDED THAT SO LONG AS THE UNDERSIGNED IS RESIDENT IN THE COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA SUCH ALTERATIONS OR ADDITIONS SHALL NOT BE MADE WITHOUT HIS SANCTION.
