GUEST SPEAKER

John Ward briefly explained power reticulation in the Wonga Park  
area, the reasons for the recent power outages and the steps being  
taken by the SECV to provide a more reliable power supply. John  
stressed that any power fluctuations or problems should be  
reported to assist the SECV in identifying and fixing any problems.

COUNCILLOR'S REPORT/GENERAL BUSINESS:

Council are to recommend that the area behind the bus shelter on  
the Jumping Creek Rd/Yarra Rd Cnr be fully fenced off to prevent  
vehicles from using the area as a pick-up drop-off point for  
school children, in response to objections from nearby residents.  
The meeting strongly defended the need for this area to continue  
to be available.

There was discussion about the proposal for additional shopping  
floorspace on the Jumping Creek Rd/Dudley Rd site and the position  
of the Association was again reaffirmed. However, the Councillors  
present suggested a public meeting may be needed to ascertain the  
feeling of the community for both this proposal and the proposal  
for expansion of the Wonga Park Village Shopping Centre.
