

MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY MEETING OF THE
WONGA PARK DISTRICT RESIDENTS' ASSOCIATION ON
9TH MAY, 1980

The meeting opened at 8.08 p.m..

1. PRESENT: M. Blunn (Chairman), J. Pitt (Secretary), and 15 members.
2. APOLOGIES: R. Yorke, D. Robinson, J. Lloyd, H. Box, A. & J. Aird, J. Jameson.
3. MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: Circulated and confirmed (J. Upton/P. Robinson - carried)
4. BUSINESS ARISING: Nil.
5. TREASURER'S REPORT: By Proxy. Financially healthy state exists. L. Hickley suggested the Treasurer handle petty cash. Moved that the President have the authority to appoint an Assistant Treasurer to operate in the absence of the Treasurer (J. Penwill/C. Lloyd - carried).
6. CORRESPONDENCE:
Inwards: four letters -
 - (i) Lilydale Highland Pipe Band thanking W.P.D.R.A. for donation.
 - (ii) Minister for Planning - details procedure to be followed re Amendment IIIA, and indicating W.P.D.R.A. views would be considered.
 - (iii) Town and Country Planning Board - re-iterating (ii) re copy they received (of W.P.D.R.A. letter to Minister for Planning)
 - (iv) Shire of Lillydale - setting out sewerage requirements for dwellings in Wonga Park (reply to earlier letter).
7. GENERAL BUSINESS
 - (i) J. Penwill outlined discussions as per April Committee Meeting re Mt. Lofty, and suggested that since an interim decision was likely within two weeks (from the State Government), no further moves be made until it was released.
 - (ii) Moved that a letter be written to the Shire of Lillydale requesting re-painting of the fogline along its section of Jumping Creek Road (J. Upton/C. Lloyd).
 - (iii) Moved that letters be sent to Shires of Lillydale and Doncaster/Templestowe, and the C.R.B., requesting reconstruction/repair of Jumping Creek bridge, and widening of the road, mentioning the increased traffic flow since repaving of Hughes Road.
 - (iv) Differential Ratings Meeting. J. Upton reported the meeting at the Shire offices was inconclusive. A letter from the Shire Secretary to the responsible Minister was tabled.
 - (v) Moved that the Duplicator sub-committee be authorised to proceed with duplicator purchase upon receipt by the Treasurer of the duplicator grant (P. Fallon/T. Van Wegberg - carried)..

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 - (vi) Hall Committee - P. Robinson indicated generally things are running well.
 - (vii) Youth in Wonga Park. M. Blunn suggested a problem existed at weekends re lack of worthwhile activity.

- Perhaps the W.P.D.R.A. and local parents should be concerned and meet to discuss.
- D. Goodwin to liaise with local Youth Group on this matter.
- (viii) Community Services Directory. The W.P.D.R.A. endorsed continued development of this Directory, and agreed to fund printing of 200 copies using the Community Cottage duplicator.
- (ix) Transport Survey. The sub-committee concerned is to report to J. Usher on the results of the survey and its interpretations.
- (x) Attendance at W.P.D.R.A. meetings. Means of improvement in this to be discussed at the next Committee meeting.
