- (ii) Moved Theo Van Wegberg seconded that a letter be sent to the Lillydale Council requesting action on the building of two proposed netball courts - carried.
- (iii) Mr. Kennedy expressed the view that owing to the poor attendance of local Councillors to the W.P.D.R.A. meetings it was moved that we should approach West Riding Residents' Association in view to obtaining their backing for a local candidate to seek endorsement for the next Council elections. Seconded Greg Harrison - carried.
- (iv) A petition of 125 signatures collected by Dean Kennedy, Campbell McLeod and Patrick (Theo's son) was presented at the meeting seeking the approval and backing of W.P.D.R.A. to approach the Lillydale Council to fund and build a bicycle track on the Council Reserve, Wonga Park.
