Cr. Smith reported on Local Drainage Scheme for Northern side of Jumping Creek Rd., including St. Denys Cres. and Toppings Rd. to alter the flow of water from west to South. Local Football club have applied for lease of lower oval and club rooms for next 10 years. Lillydale council have issued a committee of management handbook for release soon.

State government have served notices to owners re purchase of land along the Yarra Riv.

Mr. A. Aird moved that this association write to the Lillydale Council to express our concern that the name of Wonga Park may be lost in the proposed extension of the Warrandyte National Park to include the river frontages of "Yarra Brae" and "Stan Brae".

Therefore we are to suggest that the name of "Wonga Park" be included in the naming of the new park. Seconded by L. Hickling..... carried. Copy to be sent to local State M.P.

Park Management Committee report: Mr. J. Upton reported that copies of their meeting are to be sent to local councillors and that the B.M.X. track and toilet block are high on the priorities

General Business:
