Minutes of meeting held 8.00 p.m. Friday 10th September 1993

PRESENT: Dennis Easterby (Chairman for the meeting), Barry Box, Drew Diamond, Alastair Traill, Carol Traill, Murray Couper and Sue Couper

MINUTES: The minutes of the previous meeting were not available and their approval was deferred to the next meeting.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Current balance \$545.64. Barry Box moved that we send a cheque for \$50.00 to the Community Cottage in payment of rent even though we have not received an account, seconded by Carol Traill - carried.

COUNCILLOR'S REPORT: No Councillor present.

GENERAL BUSINESS: Last Sunday the Wonga Park Environmental Group planted approximately 100 plants in the Reserve between the Hall car park and Yarra Road. There will be a joint effort tree planting in Launderers Avenue with SEC, Council and Friends of Warrandyte State Park and local residents on Sunday 5th October. Upton dams have been repaired and some fencing work carried out. Sue Couper moved that we write to the Council asking when they are going to plant the mulched area at the corner of Dawes and Yarra Roads. Barry Box moved that we write to the Council supporting the retention of the Baby Health Centre in Wonga Park, seconded by Murray Couper - carried. Alastair Traill moved that we write a letter of protest to Melbourne Water about the raw sewage flowing down Jumping Creek, apparently from the pumping station near Gibson's Road, after heavy rains early in August, seconded by Drew Diamond - carried. Alastair Traill has found cysts in rabbits and is concerned that they may be a form of hydatids, and if so then there may be a risk of humans being contaminated via dogs. association should consider preparing a bumper issue of News & Notes and paying to have it delivered to all residents along with the Goodfellows handbill at an approximate cost of \$50.00.
