JUMPING CREEK ROAD

The Residents' Association has been concerned for some time about the dangerous nature of Jumping Creek Road and over the years has campaigned to the Shire of Lillydale to take action to make it safer. The Shire has responded by widening the road, improving the surface, painting white side lines, installing warning signs, painting raised yellow lines on a particularly dangerous corner and constructing the double traffic islands at the Yarra, Dudley and Jumping Creek Roads intersection. However the road is still dangerous with an unfortunate record of accidents and fatalities.

The Association is now putting pressure on the City of Doncaster and Templestowe to fix up its end of Jumping Creek Road from just west of Jumping Creek Reserve to the Warrandyte Ringwood Road, which is of considerably poorer standard than the part in the Shire of Lillydale, and which was recently the scene of a fatal accident. It has written to the Shire of Lillydale requesting that a speed limit of 60 kph be imposed along the full length of Jumping Creek Road. It has also written to the Victoria Police requesting them to actively police the existing

60 kph speed limit in Jumping Creek road from Yarra road to Homestead Road.
