which sum has been duly paid become entitled to a grant in fee simple of the surface and down to the depth of FIFTY feet below the surface of the land hereinafter described Row know ye that in consideration of the sum so paid and in pursuance of the law Us in that behalf enabling WE DO HEREBY GRANT unto CYRIL EDWARD RICE of Yarra Road Croydon Orchardist

so much and such parts as lie above the depth of FIFTY feet below the surface of HII THAT PIECE OF LAND in the said State containing thirty-nine acres two roods and twelve perches more or less being Allotment fourteenH in the Parish of Warrandyte County of Evelyn
