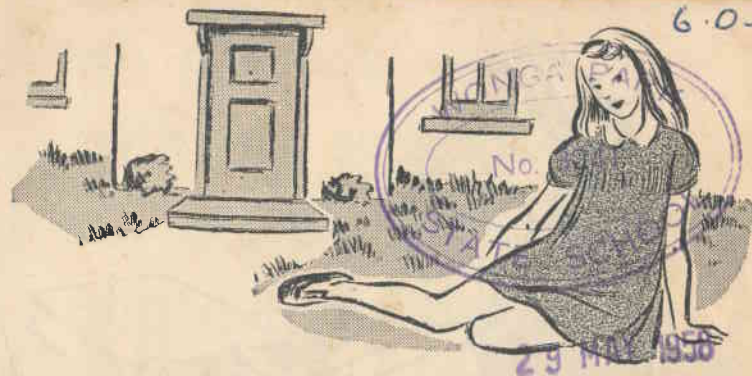

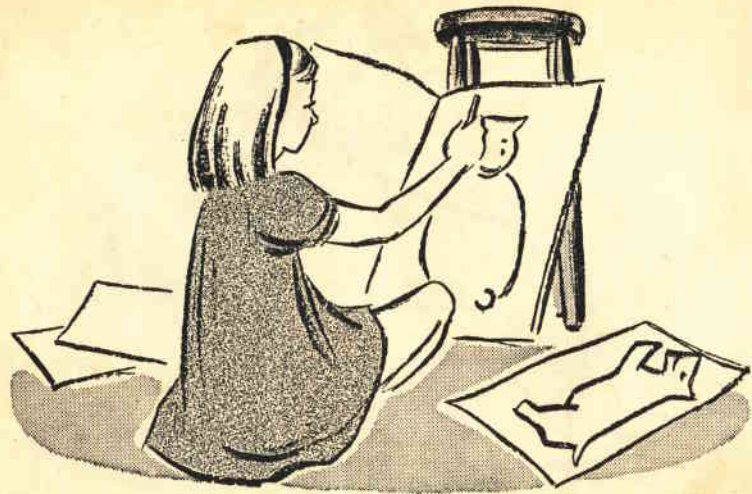


I am little girl Pat.

in my book.

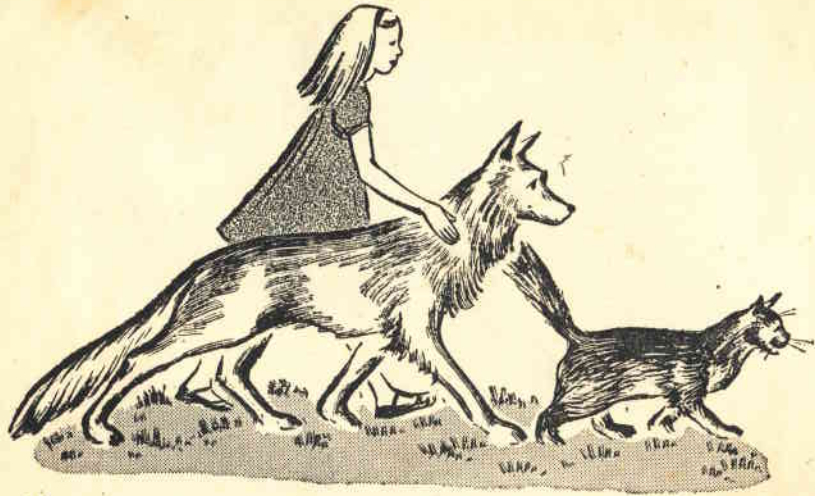
I can tap with my feet

Pitter patter, tap, tap.

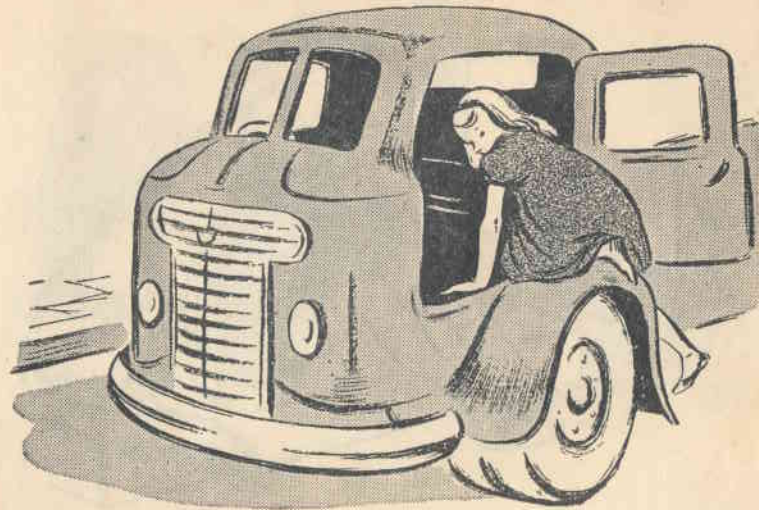




I can go out
