

Digitisation Report - for Financial Year 2018-2019

The Digitisation of our music library commenced in late May 2019.

Our music library has over 1491 Tunes. Scanning has commenced at "A" with a total of 24 pieces fully scanned, and 34 pieces partly scanned.

Each set of music has approximately 20 parts, with a total of 776 parts scanned so far.

There is still a way to go, but I'm confident the band could complete the scanning of the library in 5 years.

Any help is appreciated, and no previous experience is needed.

Thank you to Brad Morris and Miriam Maddern for their assistance with the music library.

The band has also registered as a contributor to Victorian Collections. This is a State initiative for small museums to catalogue their collections and make them accessible for future generations. We currently have 30 items catalogued.

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT TO THOMPSONS FOUNDRY BAND Inc.

Report on the Financial Report

I have audited the accompanying Financial Report, being a special purpose financial report, of Thompsons Foundry Band Inc (The Band) which comprises the Balance Sheet as at 30 June 2019 and Profit & Loss for the year ended 30 June 2019

In my opinion, the Financial Report presents a true and fair view of the Band's financial position as at 30th June 2019 and its financial performance for the year ended on that date

Basis for Opinion.

I conducted my audit in accordance with the Australian Auditing Standards. These Auditing Standards require that I comply with relevant ethical requirements relating to audit engagements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the financial report is free from material misstatement, to assess the matter of 'going concern' and to highlight any material uncertainties. In conducting my audit I have complied with the independence requirements of Australian professional ethical pronouncements. I believe that the audit evidence I have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for my opinion.

Other Information

The 'Balance Sheet' is a statement of the Financial Position of the Band as at the balance date. The Balance Sheet However, the Balance Sheet excludes the value of the Band's tangible assets. The club possesses, and has maintained in good order, furniture, instruments and portable equipment. The insured value of these items is \$40,500 Current ACNC recommendation is for a Statement of Financial Position to include the value of those assets in order to arrive at a fair value of Members Accumulated Funds.

Australian Accounting Standards are currently under review in respect of Leases. The Band enjoys rent-free permissive occupancy of premises. The Band also has the use of a car park under formal long-term lease. In terms of the financial dimensions of its annual revenues Band falls below the threshold for reporting of these arrangements but Members should be aware of the Accounting bodies' concern that 'peppercorn rental' arrangements, if recorded at fair (commercial) value would disclose that the band enjoys an effective annual subsidy from its landlords..

Responsibility for the Financial Report

The officers are responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial report. This responsibility includes designing, implementing and maintaining internal controls relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of the financial report that is free from material misstatement whether due to fraud or error,

Auditor's Responsibility for the Audit of the Financial Report

My responsibility is to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial report as a whole is free from material misstatement whether due to fraud or error and to issue a report that includes my opinion. An audit involves performing procedures in relation to audit evidence and the exercise of professional scepticism about the amounts and disclosures in the financial report. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers high risk areas, significant transactions and internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the financial report in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances. An audit includes;-

- evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the officers
- obtaining an understanding of the Band's internal control relevant to the audit
- evaluating the overall presentation of the financial report.

My audit has included a review of the supporting documentation for disbursements and suitable sampling of the items of income.

In my opinion the books of the Band have been properly kept.
