Stamp Signacula – Inscriptions found on movable articles

These inscriptions appear to have been made on seals or stamped insigniae made of bronze in the shape of a fish, a heart, a circle or a square. It could have been used for a variety of purposes but in particular ? articles of consumption.

cEleris – Q. Grani has been found at Pompeii

Veri – Ser - at Herculaneum imprinted on bread.

It seems likely therefore, that this inscription relates to the debris across the floor of the statue rather than to the sculptor/s
