UNCOMPLETED HERCULES STATUE.

- Following and attack on the Stoddart Statue of Hercules a sculptor was engaged by the Council to prepare a copy.
- Having got half way through doing so he gave up the task.
- The statue now resides at the back of the Clark Centre awaiting an explanatory panel
- In its way it provides an insight how sculptures are copied as various stages are demonstrated.
- The original Hercules showed lines and markings used by the sculptor for the necessary references and measurements but these have been removed when the statues were recently renovated by Jude Schalinger.
