15. BALLARAT BOTANIC GARDEN - GORDON COTTAGE ~~45/95/2 RJW~~

1. That subject to the Council firstly resolving the issue of the proposal in relation to the reservation of the land with the Department of Conservation Forests and Lands, and subject to the Council obtaining the necessary Planning approval from the Ministry for Planning and the Environment, the Council agree that -

.1 The Friends of the Botanic Gardens become the responsible body for the Adam Lindsay Gordon Cottage on behalf of Council.

.2 The Y's Mens' Club of Ballarat be permitted to undertake the task of restoring the Cottage as a Community Project at the direction of appropriate Council staff.

.3 Part or all of the \$5,000 available from the Gordon Cottage Committee through the Friends of the Botanic Gardens be available to the Y's Mens' Club for restoration purposes.
