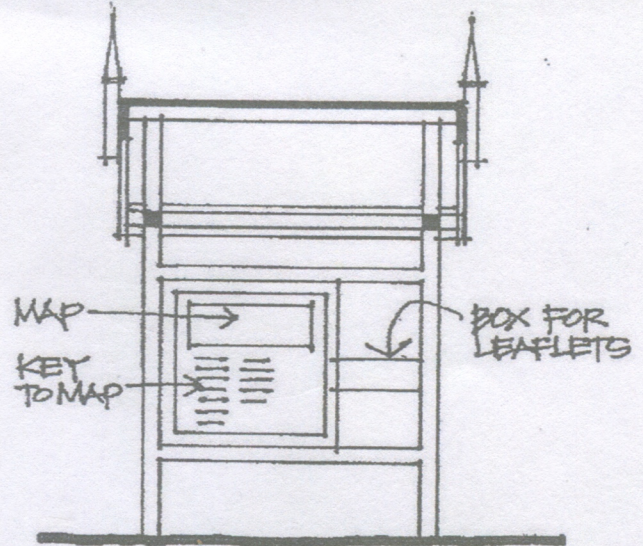
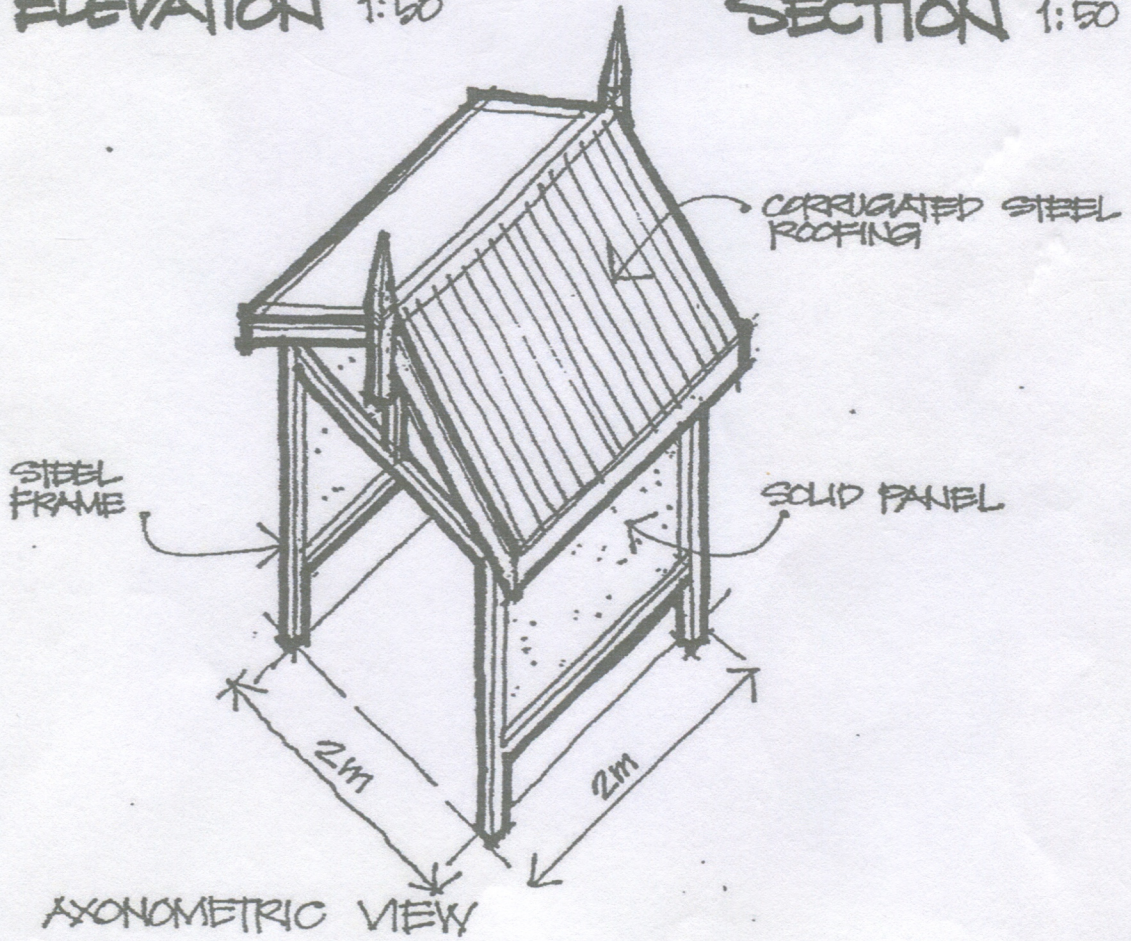


SIDE ELEVATION 1:50

THE LYCH GATE > BALLARAT BOTANICAL GARDENS.

The Lych Gate was erected in the Ballarat Botanical gardens in 1997 to celebrate the 75th anniversary of the establishment of the Ys Men's International in Toledo, Ohio, USA in 1922. Councillor J Coghlan was the Mayor at the time and K. Ferrier the President of the Ballarat Y's Men's Club. The Y's men's club had previously been involved in the refurbishment of the Gordon cottage nearby in association with the School of Mines, Ballarat, building section.
