

DAVID HAM.

- Born 4/11/1830. Launcells, Cornwall.
- Arrived Port Phillip July 1/1849
- Business Geelong/ Farming Indented Heads 1850 – 1
- Buninyong – Mining, saw milling, Estate agency, share broking in Smythesdale and Ballarat,
- Mined in Little Bendigo and Canadian Gully, in 1853 Brown's hill.
- 1854 bought 1st. sausage machine on diggings.
- 1860s > N.Z. with Morey re. Mining.
- On return had lost money due to bad management by man left in charge, but recovered.
- 1876 >JP, then MLC.
- Donated two Lions to Botanical gardens (Morey the Entrance Gates.)
- Considered Lions should be outside the Gates.(So did others,See Courier 18/8/1894)
- Note Lions have human teeth.(? horse)
- Died 3/1/1908 in Queenscliff
