THE GODS AND GODDESSES OF ANCIENT GREECE AND ROME.

The mythology of the Greek gods and goddesses were later adopted by the Romans with a change of name.

JUPITER or JOVE/ ZEUS was not able to appear to "non divine" (i.e.) mortals as his appearance in full glory was too overwhelming causing death to the mortal.

The statues purchased by Stoddart at Carrara have the Roman/Latin name'

The statues in the Gardens were not as originally Stoddart intended as Apollo and Minerva were unavailable so Bacchante and Flora Farnese were purchased instead.

ZEUS, Married to Hera.-> Ares, Hebe and Eileithyia Liaisons with:-

Metis, a Titan. -> Athene and a son but swallowed Metis and Athene born from his head fully armed!

Leto. -> Artemis and Apollo Thetis. MAKAMIK YBU, "DIVINE" Eurynome. Demeter. ->Perephone Maia -> Hermes (Mercury) Thetis. -> passed off to Peleus -> Achilles. Danae -> Perseus Shower of Gold

Alkmene -> Herakles (Hercules) see essay. Appeared as husband Amphytrion.

Leda -> Polydeuces and Helen, Castor and Clytemnestra. Swan

Semele True form (persuaded by Hera) -> Incineration

Antiope Zetheus and Antiope

Ganymede Trojan youth
