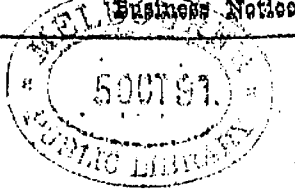

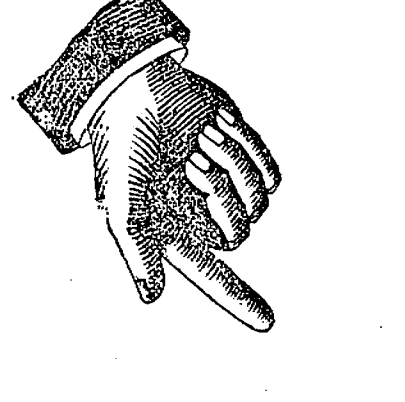

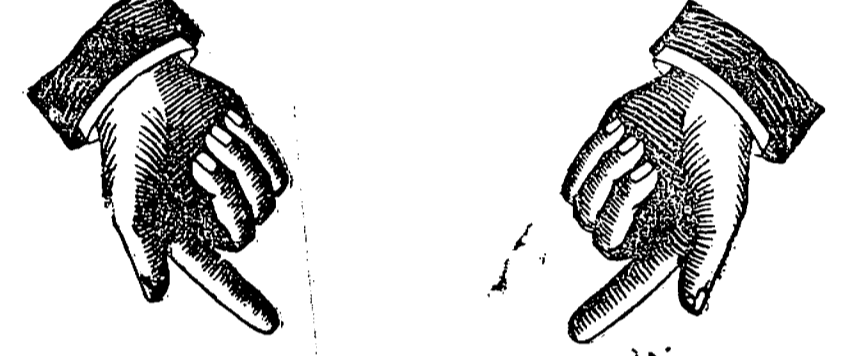

NOBODY WANTS THAT GOLD RING.—For nearly 100 years a certain family of working people living in Paris had ended their lives by suicide. The Legislative Assembly had a long sitting on Thursday night (says the Argus), but ultimately disposed of all the clauses of the Constitution Act Amendment Bill. Before members could resume the consideration of that bill a discussion was started on the question of floating a loan. According to the new standing order the first order of the day on every third Thursday must be for the consideration of supply, this being arranged to give members an opportunity of ventilating grievances. Sir Bryan O'Loughlin, in a strong manner, a grievance, which was that there was not enough money in the colony. The House debated that and other questions raised incidentally for nearly two hours, and then resumed the debate on the dual vote question. It was to be noted that the electrical conditions which prevailed on previous evenings had not been modified. Members were thoroughly imbued with the fighting spirit, and generally speaking, the proceedings were brisk and entertaining. Ultimately the dual vote proposal was defeated by 46 votes to 33, and when the result was announced to the House both sides cheered vehemently. The minority were quite satisfied. They knew that the Council would not pass the bill after so large a minority had voted for a vital amendment. Clause 4 provided that if a person were on the roll for more than one district he might select which he should vote in, but Mr. Richardson moved an amendment to limit this to the district in which he resided. The alteration was agreed to by 44 to 15, but Mr. Wheeler and Mr. Duffy broke away from the Government on the question, and voted with the

minority. The other clauses, excepting those providing for women's suffrage (which were struck out), were agreed to, and then the Government successfully resisted several amendments, including one by Mr. Derham for enabling sailors absent at sea to vote at elections. The bill having been reported, with amendments, the House adjourned at 20 minutes to 1 o'clock.
