ARTIFICIAL FERTILISERS: THEIR NATURE AND USE.

By B. Leslie Emille, C.D.A., F.A.S.I., F.C.S. FERTILISERS EMPLOYED AS A SOURCE OF POTASH. From a study of the early history of fertilizing, it appears that the materials employed were largely phosphatic and nitrogenous.

WOOD ASHES. The extraction of potash from wood ashes for exportation to Europe where it was employed in various manufactures, was at one time a very important Canadian industry.

POTASH SALTS. Kainit (12.4 per cent. potash)—This is a crude potash salt, which, without further treatment than grinding, is extensively employed as a potash fertilizer in Europe.

GREEN MANURING. Green manuring is effective both on sandy and heavy clay soils, and, indeed, in all soils deficient in humus. On sandy soils its effect is to consolidate the soil, and in clay soils to act by 'loosening' the tangle.
