### HOUSEHOLD HINTS.

If you wash a pan in which fish has been fried with strong salt and water it will remove the fish smell more quickly than if soda-water is used.

When mending coats, iron, cutting up and cutting from their proper places on polished cloth or linoleum line them with a piece of old carpet. Hook rusty metal fastenings in place for a day before you start cleaning. Then rub well with a damp rag dipped in fine sand, and finish off with emery.

To test the heat of an oven for cakes, put in a piece of white paper. If at the end of five minutes the paper is quite yellow, the oven is at the right temperature.

A breakfast pudding will take an hour less to cook, if before the meat is put in a small hole is made in the bottom of the meat crust. This enables the heat to reach the meat quickly.

Here is a recipe for removing shiny marks from skirts. After having made holes, pour hot water over the remaining grounds. Dip a piece of cloth into this and rub the shiny parts of the dress.

Vinegar added to the water in which fish is boiled will make the fish firm and add to its flavor.

If you are mending jam, rub the bottom of the bottle of the jar with a little salad-oil. It won't hurt the jam, and it helps to prevent it from sticking to the bottom of the jar.

For cleaning white or light-colored felt hats, ground rice is invaluable. Rub the rice thoroughly into the felt with a piece of white rag, then brush out with a clean soft brush.

To prevent a cake from becoming heavy after being taken out of the oven, allow the steam to escape from it. This can be done by putting the cake on a wire mesh-stand, or by over-boiling potatoes in to give steam in a cloth, glasses, hard, or any other thing, and then brush out with a clean soft brush.

When not in use, wooden buckets and wash-basins should have about two inches of water left in them. This prevents them from becoming too dry and the wood from shrinking so that they leak.

To prevent fat making the stove dirty when frying, place a piece of paper over the frying pan. This will catch all grease and will not be detrimental to the contents of the pan.

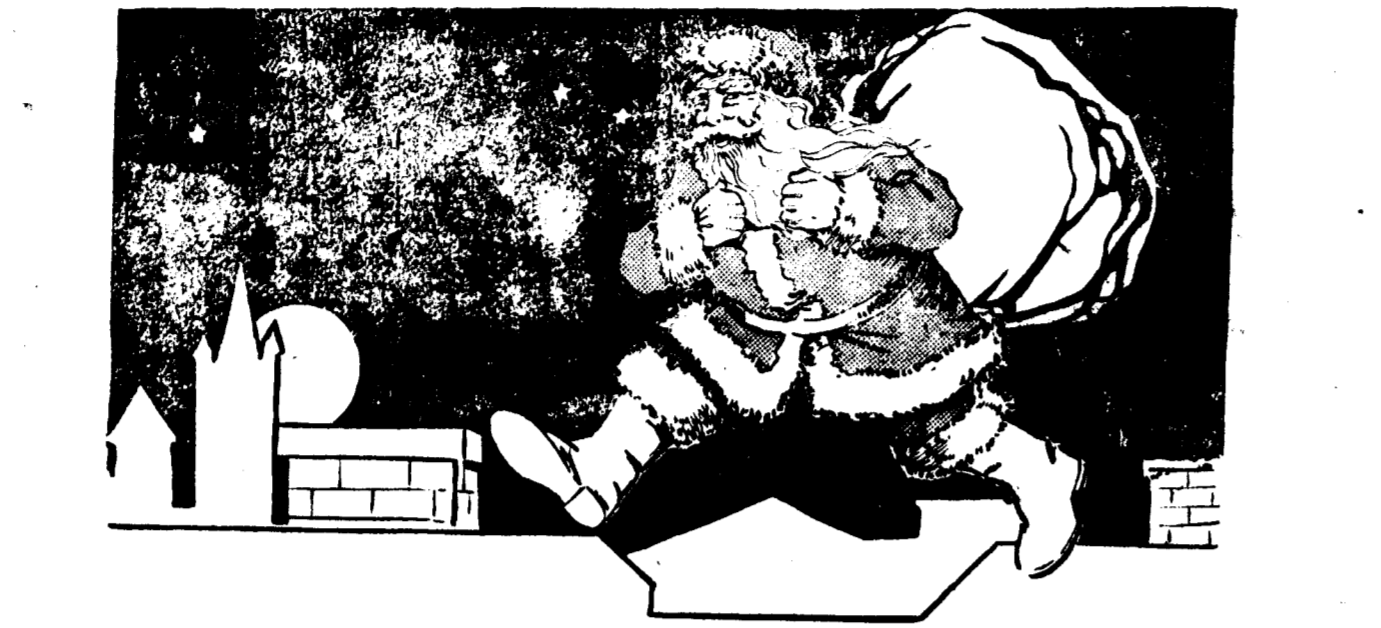
