FISHING WITH DRUGS.
The most curious method of fishing is that employed by the natives who inhabit the upper reaches of the river of the Malay Peninsula. When they decide to go fishing they send messengers to the other villages down the river to warn them that the water is going to be poisoned. Then two kinds of trees are tapped for their sap. Although the saps are quite harmless apart, when the two are mixed with the waters of the river they become a strong stupefying drug. The drug is thrown into the river, turning it milky white, and immediately all the fish come to the surface. Canoes are used to collect the fish, for in a few hours the stream has cleared and the fish have revived. The river Tigra contains surprising numbers of huge fish, which are caught in the easiest possible manner. He uses a net occasionally, but that is of little use for catching the real big fish. When he goes after them he proceeds to poison the river with dough; not the innocent compound of flour and water used for making bread, but a thick sticky paste into which a quantity of opium has been mixed. Any fish that makes a meal of this is quickly stupefied and floats to the surface. The fishermen then wade in on inflated goat skins and go out to collect the bag. Things have not changed much on the Tigra in the last 2,000 years. The boats used now are identical in shape with those seen in Babylonian sculptures, and the goat skin floats have been employed in Mesopotamia for more than a hundred generations.

DASH THAT FIRES BULLETS.
Can you imagine a gun which makes neither noise nor smoke, when its cartridges, is cocked entirely by a pistol on line, and can shoot 1,000 rounds a minute at ranges up to 2,000 yards? Such a weapon is being tested by the military authorities. It works in the principle of centrifugal force—the same force that flings mud out to your back when you are cycling on a wet day or causes flat tyres in factories to burst suddenly into hundreds of fragments. Anything that is placed upon a revolving wheel is carried to its edge and then hurled off. The new gun consists of a metal basin in which are placed a quantity of round steel bullets. As the basin is whirled at enormous speed by a petrol motor the bullets are allowed to escape from an opening in the disc. Shutters are provided which prevent the bullets from being hurled out except at one point. One feature of the gun is that it can be rapidly to meet the requirements of the occasion. So the magazine rapidly and its missiles will crash through an open plain a mile away. But let it revolve at a low speed and it will pour out a stream of bullets which will, but do not kill, at even such a short range as twenty yards.

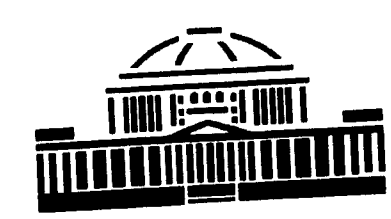
