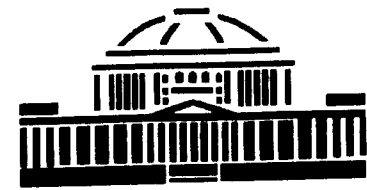

In State political circles it is believed that the R-dist short of Seats Bill will not be submitted to the Legislative Assembly this year but will be reserved for a session to begin earlier than usual next year.
