NOTICE THEIR EYEBROWS.

Did you know that eyebrows are considered as almost an infallible indication of character?

If the eyebrows are straight and horizontal, you may take it as an indication of a firm and active mind; whilst if they are slightly curved it is a sign of firmness united with kindness of nature.

Rough, rugged eyebrows denote a quick and uncontrollable temper in their owner, but if they are thin, it is an indication of weakness and indifference.

FISHING IN WALNUT SHELLS.

When the Romans went to Britain nearly two thousand years ago they were amazed to see the tiny boats in which the inhabitants of England navigated great streams like the Thames and the Severn.

They were just like the halves of walnut shells, and so light that a man could carry his craft easily in one hand.

Similar boats are in use to-day in the south-western corner of Wales, where fishermen who are the direct descendants of the ancient Britons still use them to ply their trade.

Near the mouth of the River Teify you will see men coming down to the water carrying on their backs what look like large black dish-covers. They are coracles, made of thin wooden frames covered with tarpaulin.

The fisherman launches his craft, steps in, and paddles out calmly into the rushing waters, where he sets about the shooting of his salmon nets.

If you want a real thrill, put on your oldest clothes and try to paddle a coracle yourself. It is quite a business to get in, for the boat is only about four feet long. But it is no trouble to get out, as you will find after two or three strokes of the paddle—the coracle does that for you! That is why it is advisable to choose shallow water for your first attempt.

FLIES' WONDERFUL FEATS.

When a man walks four miles in an hour, he takes about 1,760 paces in fifteen minutes, or nearly a hundred and twenty a minute.

If this man were quickened to a run, a thousand paces would be taken in five minutes, or two hundred a minute. Sprinting, the rate might be raised to nearly three hundred paces a minute.

But if a human being could move his legs as fast as the ordinary house-fly moves its wings, the pace would rise from three hundred paces per minute to 19,000, and the ground would simply be dashed over! Supposing that you stride a yard in walking, you would cover 19,000 yards, or more than eleven miles, in a minute.

If I had the quickness of muscular movement possessed by the fly we should indeed be wonderful athletes. This insect is able to move its wings at the rate of three hundred and fifty beats to the second. He is busier in wing-beat of only one hundred and ninety to the second.

When we study these figures of wing-power we find that the fly is a creature to be respected and envied. He leads the world in actual muscular energy, and is relatively a giant in strength.

A man or a horse does well enough if he pulls his own weight. A beetle thinks nothing of his own weight. He waddles it multiplied several times over before he feels that he has got a pulling job really worthy of his powers.

AN ANCIENT INDUSTRY.

Which is the world's oldest industry? This is an interesting question that is certainly difficult to answer, but there is little doubt that basket-making can claim to be one of the most ancient of those still in existence.

From the remotest times the Chinese excelled in the manufacture of baskets, and they are still considered the world's best craftsmen in this respect, their careful work being the envy of Western manufacturers.

They make their household baskets so closely and firmly that they can be used in many cases to hold water, and are excellent substitutes for buckets. This naturally means great skill and patience in the manufacture, which is only attained through years of practice.

The tremendous number of willow-trees growing in China supply the necessary material.

Basket-making is also one of the longest-established of British industries, and the old Britons were noted at Rome for their baskets. The form in which these baskets were made changed but little until the nineteenth century, when new styles and shapes were introduced.

At a meeting of the Skipton Progress Association on Saturday night, complaint was made of the dangerous practice of the Ripon Shire Council in dumping metal in the centre of the roadway, opposite the court-house, without even a light thereon to direct attention.
