

OUTLAWS OF THE WILD.

There are animals that have not a friend in the world; there are some, indeed, which are so harmful that prices are set upon their heads, and it is considered the duty of all to kill them.

Such a creature is the dingoo, or wallaby of Australia, which is the worst foe of the sheep farmer. It is a cowardly beast, yet cunning beyond belief.

Another terrible foe of sheep is commonly known as the Tasmanian Devil. This creature will kill a score of sheep in a night. It is being steadily destroyed by poison and other means, and is now rare.

The timber wolf of North America is also scarce without friends. It is a peculiar brute with a terrific jaw power. One of these wolves has been known to snap off a man's hand at a single bite.

It is a foe to all domestic animals and is equally hated by the stock-raiser and the trapper. One of its pleasant tricks is to trail the trapper and devour the fur-bearing creatures which he takes in his traps.

There is a price on its head. The small wolf, the speaking little coyote, is another foe to sheep. Last year over 27,000 were killed in North America, besides other thousands destroyed by poison.

Another pest is the lynx, which has nothing better than lamb. Its failing is a love for the scent of catnip, and by means of this lure it is trapped in large numbers in the States and in Canada. A curious-looking creature, it has pricked ears, large round eyes, and huge paws out of all proportion to its size.

The mountain lion, or panther of the Rockies, takes heavy toll of cattle, and is, therefore, hunted down by stockmen, who kill about two hundred every year.

One other American wild animal which is remorselessly hunted is the wolverine, a sort of giant weasel, enormously strong, intensely cunning and extremely savage. The prospector and trapper have a perfect horror of the wolverine, and with good reason, for if it finds a shack empty it will dig its way in through the roof, and ruin or destroy the whole of the stores. Many a trapper has died of starvation owing to this habit of the wolverine.

In South Africa the animal most hated is the wild dog. It hunts in packs, and once a pack starts work in a district they drive every head of game out of the country. They also kill both sheep and cattle.

Other animals are destroyed, not because they are directly foes of man, but because they eat up food which is intended for him or for his stock. The notorious case is the rabbit, imported into Australia, and which now infests the whole Continent.

The jack rabbit of America is almost equally destructive. In many of the Western States it eats more grass than the stock. In Idaho alone they kill 700,000 jack rabbits yearly, and in California nearly as many. The method employed is to drive them into corrals of wire netting, so many as 15,000 being rounded up at one time.

In British animals the most mischievous is the rat, which is said to destroy £40,000,000 worth of man's property yearly. Certainly it would be better dead. The mouse is almost equally destructive in its own way, and should be kept under by every means in our power.

HOUSEHOLD HINTS.

Here is a splendid recipe for a dainty morsel for afternoon tea. Mix together two ounces each of flour and cornflour, and half a teaspoonful of baking-powder. Rub in two ounces of the best margarine and one ounce of castor sugar.

Flavour with vanilla, and mix to a paste with the well-beaten egg or a little milk. Bake on a greased tin in little round heaps. When quite cold, place two together with a little chocolate-butter icing. The icing is made by mixing a little icing-sugar good cocoa, and butter together until it forms a stiff paste. This same icing is delicious spread over a plain maida tea-cake. Spread with the back of a knife.

Why not try a potato crust over a meat-pie for a change instead of a flour crust? Take a quarter of a pound of nicely boiled potatoes, and mix them thoroughly with the same quantity of flour into which three ounces of good beef dripping have been rubbed. Bind into a rather stiff paste with a little milk, and roll out on a well-floured board.

A little art is needed to get the crust over the pie without breaking it. The pie should be placed quite close to the crust, and the crust lifted low with both hands and quickly put into place.

Any ointments of paste over may be rolled into little flat cakes and fried in dripping. Or, if there is a morsel of cold fish in the larder, this may be freed from bones and skin and kneaded into the paste and formed into fish-balls.

I always make my own baking-powder, as I find it goes farther and is more wholesome than some of the bought kinds. Here is my recipe: Have four ounces of carbonate of soda, three of tartaric acid, and eight of rice flour or ground rice. Mix the three together and pass through a fine sieve two or three times, then put away in a tin for use.
