### DON'T WORRY!

Doctors have been gathering statistics on nervous diseases and their tendency to shorten life and have issued a remarkable bulletin against worry.

"So far as is known," the bulletin says, "no bird ever tried to build more nests than its neighbour; no fox ever fretted because he had only one hole in which to hide; no squirrel ever died of anxiety lest he should not lay by enough nuts for two winters instead of one; and no dog ever lost any sleep over the fact that he did not have enough bones laid aside for his declining years."

### A CLERICAL APPETITE.

The menu of old books, whether encyclopaedical or other, fills the reader with an awestricken sense of the capacity of our ancestors for absorbing food.

Such meals as they used to eat! According to modern ideas of hygiene they ought all to have died early from diseases of overnutrition. Yet many of them lived to an advanced age. A recently discovered and published work, the Diary of the Rev. James Woodville, an English country parson, is full of evidence concerning the gargantuan appetites of the eighteenth century. The reverend gentleman takes simple delight in recording his menus.

He notes a country meal for fifteen persons—

"We had for dinner a boiled Rump Beef 4lb., weight, a ham and half a dozen Fowls, a roasted Saddle of Mutton, two very rich puddings, and a good Sallet with a fine cucumber."

As a fellow of New College, Oxford, and a subwarden, he ordered dinner every day. "We had for dinner two fowls (cold), a boiled and fried souf round them and oyster sauce, a fine Sirloin of Beef roasted, some pea soup, and an orange pudding for the first course; for the second we had a lease of Wild Ducks roasted, a fore Quarter of Lamb and sallad and Mince Pies. After the second course there was a fine plum cake brought to the senior Table, as is usual on this day, which also goes to the Bachelors after. We had Rabbits for supper roasted, as is usual on this day. The Sub-Warden has one to himself, the Bursars each one piece, the Senr. Fellows 1 a one each, the Junr. Fellows a rabbit between three."

But at the House they had a "very elegant" dinner. "The first course was part of a large Cod, a China of Mutton, some Soup, a Chicken Pie, Puddings and Roasts, etc. Second course, Triguons and Asparagus, a Fillet of Veal with Mushrooms and high Sauce with it, roasted Sweetbreads, hot Lobster, Apricot Tart, and in the middle a Pyramid of Syllabubs and Jellies. We had Desert of Fruit after Dinner and Madeira White Port and red to drink as wine. We were all very cheerful and merry."

At Bransome on Shrove Tuesday they had "Lamb Soup to drink, a composition of ale, sugar, etc., lobsters, pancakes, etc., to eat at supper, and the butler there gives a plum cake with a copy of verses of his own making upon it."

### FLATS AT £1,000 A WEEK.

Flat-dwellers in London who are grumbling at the high rents they have to pay may derive some consolation from the fact that rents are far higher in New York.

According to a recently issued report, a suite in one of the sumptuous "apartment houses" in the fashionable "uptown" district costs, to rent, from £5,000 to £11,000 a year, according to the accommodation.

These rents, moreover, are for just ordinary suites. For what are known as the "suites de luxe," or the "millionaires' suites," of which every big apartment house boasts at least two or three, £200 to £1,000 a week is charged.

### HORSE'S PULLING POWER.

There can be no doubt that weight is an important factor in the production of a horse that can pull a heavy load. This has long been recognized in America, where for many years draught horses, pure-bred and commercial, have been sold by weight; and it has recently been definitely proved by the Oowa dynamometer, a machine for measuring the pulling power of a horse.

It has been absolutely shown that a pair of horses cannot exert a tractive pull greater than their own weight. A tractive pull is not merely the pulling of a heavy load over a required distance, but the maintenance of the pull required to start that load over a distance which is now fixed at 27 1/2 feet.

Thus, the weight of a horse is undoubtedly a limiting factor to what it can accomplish. Moreover, the fact that a horse can make a tractive pull of nine-tenths of its own weight is significant; and these two points, taken together, show that breeding for weight in horses is no mere fad or "fancy point."

### STACK MEASUREMENT.

To find the contents of an oblong stack with perpendicular ends, multiply the length by the average width (between bottom and ends) and the product by 1/2, height from the ground to the eaves. For the top multiply the area at the eaves by 1/2 the height to the right. The weight may be ascertained very accurately by measuring the cubic contents of a truss, and from this calculating the height at the top.

### ELECTRIC LIGHT.

The president of Ripon Shire (Mr. R. A. D. Sinclair), of Beaufort, accompanied by Mr. D. F. Troy and Mr. E. J. Metz (shire engineer) visited Inglewood during last week and obtained information on the electric light plant.

A meeting of the Dunroper P.W.U. members was held on Thursday, 20th inst., in the Presbyterian Church to decide whether to keep on or close, owing to the lack of members or others interested in the work. It was decided to carry on a little longer. The branch has dwindled down to only eight members.

### Pressure, intermingled with regret

was expressed at the Snake Valley State school on Friday, 21st inst., when the teachers and scholars bade farewell to Miss N. Whittia, who has received a promotion to Tocon. Two of the senior scholars presented Miss Whittia with two suit cases, to show the school's appreciation of her fine work.

### A lamentable accident, which was followed by the death of William Ernest Dodgson, occurred on Monday, on the road between Streatham and Westbury. The boy, six years of age, was the son of Mr. T. Dodgson, one of the best-known residents of Streatham. He was seated on a tin in a lorry driven by Hurtle Eastick, and when passing over a rut in the road, the resultant jolt threw the boy from his seat. Eastick made an effort to seize him with one hand while he held the reins with the other, but the boy fell over the front of the vehicle, and the wheel passed over him. It was obvious to Eastick that the boy had been seriously injured, and with all possible haste he placed the almost lifeless boy on the lorry and hurried off to the Skipton Hospital, but on arrival there the boy was dead. A medical examination showed that the boy's back had been broken. The sad circumstances have been reported to the coroner.

### A company named New Zealand Forests Limited has been registered in London with a capital of £50,000.

Arrangements have been completed by Sir George Tallis and others interested in the newly-formed Ballarat Theatre Company for the purchase of O'Donnell's Cosmopolitan hotel. Previously the company purchased the Salvation Army Hostel and Trotman's fish shop. The company now has a frontage to Lydiard street of 100 feet and a depth of 165 feet. The amount paid for the three properties aggregated £20,000. It is proposed at an early date to build a large modern theatre on the sites, costing £30,000.



The first train for Ballarat on Monday leaves Melbourne at 7.40 a.m., and those with that Monday morning feeling often feel the strain in rising at such an early hour. On 29th March Mabel G. W. wished to attend a wedding in Ballarat, and then proceed to Beaufort. Presumably she rose late and missed the first train, but acting on the advice, "better late than never," caught the 8.40 a.m. train. Ticket-checker George Williams was at this end, however, and he detected the lady booking her journey, and incidentally the regulations of the Railway Department. This combination of breakages resulted in a charge being preferred against her at the City Court on Tuesday. For having broken the journey she was fined 10/- with 7/6 costs.

### The population of Australia at December 31, 1925, was 5,992,084, according to the latest quarterly summary of Australian statistics prepared by the Commonwealth statistician (Mr. C. Wickens). The increase during the year was 118,581, made up of excess of births over deaths 81,224, and net immigration 37,357. Births totalled 135,792, deaths 54,568 (including 7251 children under one year of age), and marriages 46,899. Both birth rate, 22.89 per 1000, and death rate, 9.20 per 1000, were the lowest ever recorded in Australia. The infantile mortality rate was the second lowest experienced. The Commonwealth public debt on 31st December, 1925, was £40,483,838. A decrease of £6,672,546 during the quarter. The number of Savings Banks accounts open at 31st December, 1925, was 4,071,149, and the amount of deposit £184,971,977, representing £30/17/5 per head of population.
