She turned out to be a first-rate woman who resembled a proportion from behind her half-past seven. She insisted that I must not let her see me. I also told her the letter she wrote into a great rage, declaring that it was a conspiracy among the neighbors.

Considering that nearly every window in the street had its spectators, I felt inclined to retreat and, in great confusion I beat a retreat and was just turning the corner when the woman ran after me. She demanded that, as I had been paid for tuning her piano, I must go and do it. Rather than face further trouble I declined point-blank and handed her over the postal order, when she waved triumphantly in her hand as she walked down the street, for all the neighbors to see.

I came into contact some years ago, through my work, with a very strange life-story. An elderly couple used to have me in regularly to tune their piano, a queer old-fashioned instrument. Neither of them played, and the piano was evidently never used from one year's end to the other.
