DIAMOND JUBILEE SHOW LOCAL AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY'S 60th BIRTHDAY

1930 EXHIBITION A DISTINCT SUCCESS.

GATE TAKINGS SHOW INCREASE.

A cool day, with occasional bursts of bright sunshine, made conditions in the open agreeable on Saturday. On the occasion of the Beaufort Agricultural Society's diamond jubilee show, and there was a good attendance of residents of Beaufort and the surrounding district. The show took place at the Park, and the picturesque grounds and surrounding area were admirably prepared for the occasion. About 100 motor cars lined the area, and there were nearly 60 more parked on the roads. The gate receipts amounted to £2717/3, which represents an increase of £741 on last year. Despite the present depression, in which the pastoral and agricultural industries have been hard hit, there was a noticeable all-round improvement in the show, and the entries totalled 20717/3, which represents an increase of £741 on last year. The year's entries were made up as follows:—School work, 270; sheep, 8; horses (draughts, 48; light, 155); 205; grain, roots, and hay, 23; fruit and vegetables, 26; dairy produce, 8; poultry, 130; miscellaneous, 146; flowers, 53; dogs, 51; cattle, 8; total, 2071.

There are still a few men living who remember the first Beaufort show 60 years ago, and one of them is Mr. W. C. Pender, of Melbourne, who is the father-in-law of the present secretary of the society (Mr. G. Pringle). Mr. Pender also attended the 60th show on Saturday. The initial show was held where Messrs. J. R. Wetherston & Co.'s establishment now stands; the old iron store (now used as a motor garage) being utilised to house some of the exhibits. Although the town and district might not have progressed to the extent that the pioneers of the society in 1870 anticipated, they are far from decadent, and the descendants of most of the early pastoralists and farmers are still on the land. The district is recognised in commercial circles throughout the State as a thoroughly sound one, and is capable of greater development by future generations. In order to increase the carrying capacity of their holdings, many of our pastoralists and farmers to-day are pinning their faith to top-dressing of pastures and the sowing down of grasses. When the centenary of the society is reached 40 years hence, probably both the carrying capacity of the land in the district and the size of the town of Beaufort will have been doubled.

Although the use of motor transport has become so general, it is apparent that the day of the horse is not yet over. Light and draught horses are still the outstanding feature of the Beaufort show, and many splendid specimens of both were exhibited. The ring events proved very interesting, and competition was keen. There were no mishaps in the hunting events, although some view showed the productivity of district soils. The dairy produce was of fine quality, as was also the collection of vegetables.
