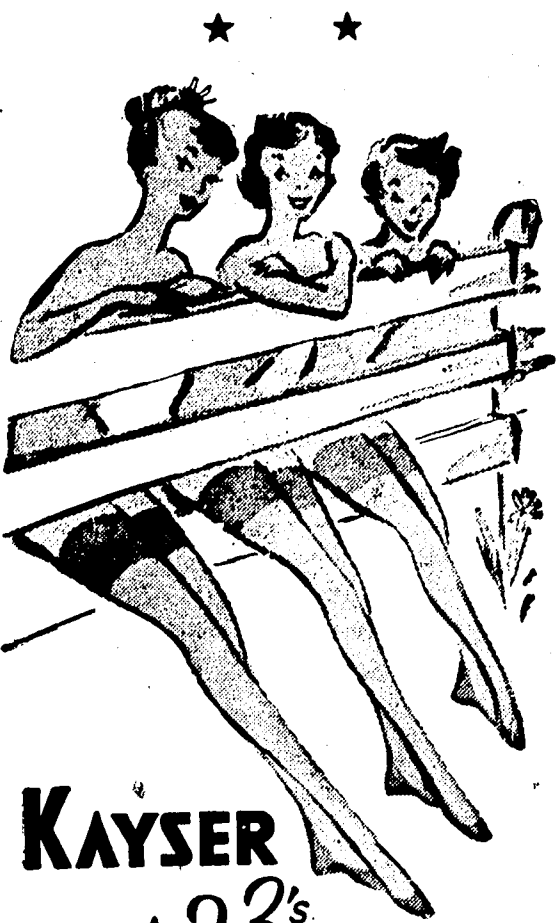

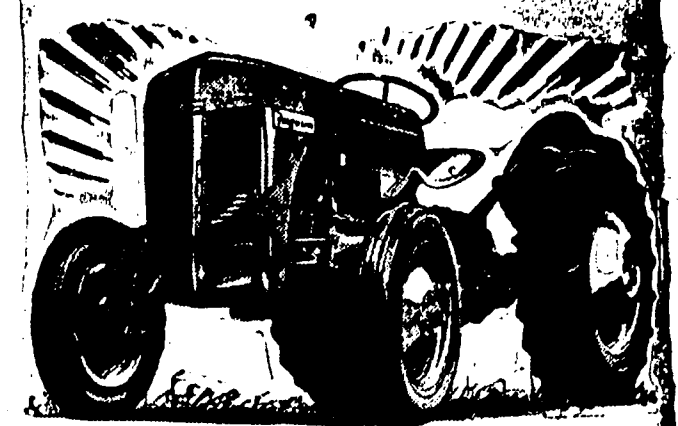
ENCLOSURES IN AEROGRAMMES

STORY BOOK SINGER TO VISIT BEAUFORT

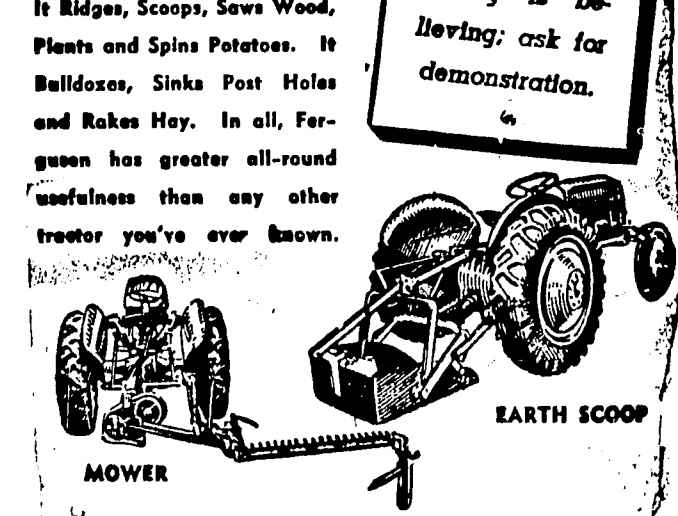
The career of Kathleen Goodall, the celebrated Australian soprano who will be heard in the Methodist Hall on Friday next, October 9, under the direction of the Council of Adult Education, reads like a story book. Showing an early aptitude for music, she commenced at the age of seven to study piano, and by the time she was 16 had passed many examinations and earned many awards. A stage career followed two years later. While singing at a private party, her voice attracted the attention of the famous Maestro Adolph Spivakovsky, who persuaded her to take up the study of lieder and opera under his direction. It was not until eight years later that Spivakovsky pronounced her ready to appear on the concert platform. Her first concert was unanimously praised by the critics, and thereafter she went from success to success. Kathleen Goodall is well known for her radio work, but this is her first big tour of Victorian towns.

SHIRE ENGINEERS' ANNUAL REPORT 1/10/1952 TO 30/9/1953. Mr President and Council members: I have the honour to present my annual report on operations of the Shire's works-organization.

2. WORKS ORGANISATION: Council's outdoor staff was reduced to 27 by a resignation. Its members are generally of 4 men with truck and power grader, further construction equipment with its operators is attached to land and Waterloo water supply and maintenance for the Beaufort Water Trust, the Snake Valley.

3. PLANT: Council's plant consists of 4 power graders (5 to 14 years old), 4 tip trucks (7 to 9 years old), 1 motor for 12 years old, with roller hose and welding generator, 1 light patrol grader (4 years old), 1 pneumatic tyre end loader (6 years old), 1 heavy duty trailer type low loader, 1 concrete mixer, power pump and fire lighting unit.

4. MANUFACTURE IN COUNCIL'S YARD AT BEAUFORT: The precasting yard has produced reinforced concrete gutter slabs have also been made for lining of earth drains in Beaufort and Snake Valley.

5. HIRED TRUCKS AND CONTRACTS: Works were generally carried out by direct labour and additional private trucks were hired at scheduled rates of 10d per cubic yard mile for cartage and 2/6 per cubic yard for loading.

6. ROAD AND BRIDGE WORKS CARRIED OUT DURING THE YEAR: The road network and our Council's control comprises 80 miles of Main roads (20 miles sealed) and 321 miles of other roads.

7. MAIN ROADS THROUGHOUT ON 80 miles including replacement of a number of direction signs. Waterloo, Travalla - Nering, Ahern's, Star's, Euramben-Ragan, Francis, Lucardie's, Balls, Drew's, and Church lanes.

8. FINANCE: The year's operations started with a debit balance of £12,000 and ended with a debit balance of £4,900.

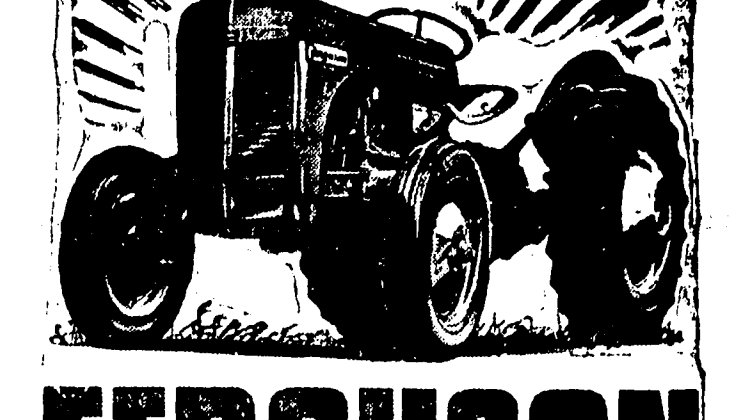

Analysis of these data shows that during a period of 69 years Council considered that the net annual valuation of all the properties in the Shire of Ripon had only increased by 60 per cent. Council is legally bound to have all properties revalued every 5 years.

From 1885 to 1915, a period of 31 years, Council's expenditure on works increased gradually and was met generally from rates only. From 1915 to 1920, a period of 5 years, Council's expenditure increased by 50 per cent.

From 1920 to 1954, a period of 34 years, Council's expenditure on works increased by 100 per cent. This increase was due to the considerable increase in the cost of construction works on the Traralgon Estate for which additional development roads were made.

Council recently let a contract for similar work at an average cost per mile of £1950 for formation, boxing and gravelling with swamp gravel on the Eurambine Soldier Settlement. In 1952/53 Council's expenditure on works was £52,000.

Unexpended balance of the Machinery Loan (£900) is available for purchase of power operated trench and chain excavator. A unit of this type is available for hire from the Council at a rate of £100 per week.

H.T.'S REPORT

Mr Ruxton reported that gifts of eggs had been allotted as follows:—Beaufort Hospital 76 doz., Ballarat Hospital 4 doz., Ballarat Orphanage 28 doz., Queen Elizabeth Home 22 doz. Diphtheria immunization had been completed. School attendance—Primary 229, secondary 73, total 302. The Secondary Board (Messrs. W. B. Russell and A. E. Schreiber) visited the school accompanied by the D.I. (Mr. C. Bryant) and Mr. Cheng, an inspector from North Borneo visiting Australia under the Colombo Plan. The Head Teacher read the Board's report on the buildings, and also extracts from a report presented to them of the school's activities. The cookery room walls had been completed, and two grease traps and open drains had been fitted alongside the cookery room. The school drainage had been re-aligned to flow out of the school ground. Another wall was to be built from the end of the cookery room wall almost to the Church of England fence. When that was done the contractors would deliver the new prefabricated classroom.
