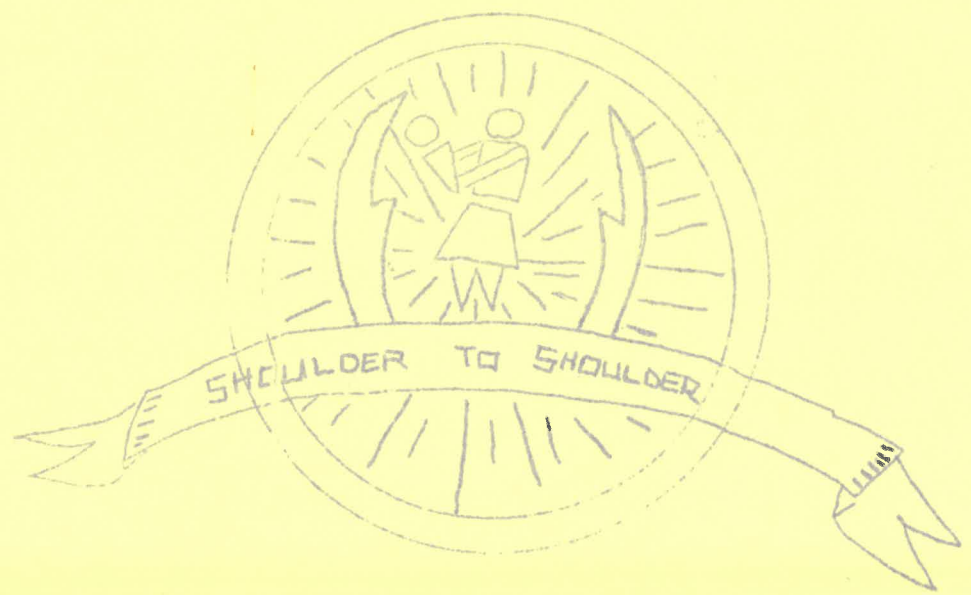

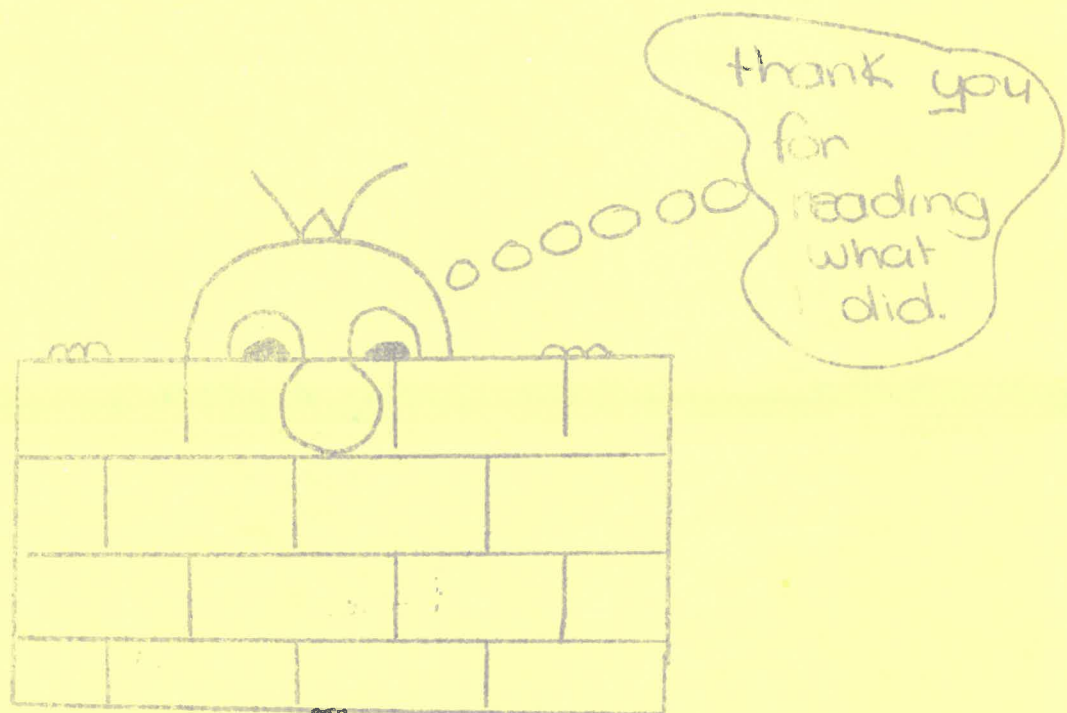

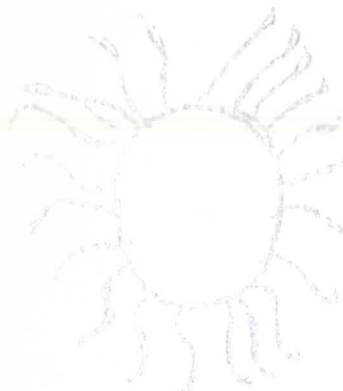
Samud.
