

What's happening?

We're renewing tram tracks along Mt Alexander Road between Mooltan Street and Dean Street, and overhead wires between Fletcher Street and Shamrock Street.

These essential works will reduce risk of derailments along this portion of the tram network. Renewal works will also deliver improved ride, comfort and safety for our passengers and ensure a quieter infrastructure for the community.

Buses replace trams on some sections of **Route 58** and **59**. Buses divert around the work zones and stop changes apply.

Mount Alexander Road will be closed to all traffic in two sections from Dean Street to Sydney Street (including the intersection at Ormond Road*) and South Street to Mooltan Street.


