Reason for service changes

Due to Metro Tunnel works for the new Anzac Station and Level Crossing removal works at Glenhuntly Station.

Service changes

Service changes affect St Kilda Road trams including Route 58.

Sunday 27 November and Saturday 17 December, 3am to 7am each day

Buses replace **Route 67** trams between Stop 14 Arts Precinct and Stop 30 St Kilda Junction.

7am Sunday 27 November to 3am Saturday 17 December

Buses replace **Route 3, 3a, 5, 6, 16, 64, 67** and **72** trams between Stop 14 Arts Precinct and Stop 25 Commercial Rd.

Buses replace **Route 58** trams between Stop 1 Flinders St and Stop 123 Fawkner Park.

Tuesday 6 December to Thursday 8 December, 8pm to last tram each day

Buses replace Route 67 trams between Stop 14 Arts Precinct and Carnegie.

Closed tram stops

The following tram stops will be closed:

Stop 17 Grant St – to city: Connect with trams at Stop 14 Arts Precinct, 400m/ 4 min walk

Stop 17 Grant St - to suburbs: Connect with buses at the footpath

Stop 19 Shrine of Remembrance – to city: Connect with buses in Dorcas St, 150m/ 2 min walk

Stop 20 Park St – to city: Connect with buses in Dorcas St, 250m/ 3 min walk

Stop 20 Park St – to suburbs: Connect with buses at Stop 19 Shrine of Remembrance, 350m/ 4 min walk

Stop 22 Toorak Rd – to city: Connect with buses at Stop 23 Arthur St, 400m/ 5 min walk

Stop 22 Toorak Rd – to suburbs: Connect with buses at a temporary stop on St Kilda Rd, 150m/ 2 min walk

Stop 22 Toorak Rd – to West Coburg: Connect with buses at Stop 123 Fawkner Park, 500m/ 6 min walk

Stop 22 Toorak Rd – to Toorak: Connect with buses at a temporary stop in Toorak Rd, 50m/ 1 min walk

Stop 119 Wells St - to West Coburg: Connect with buses on the opposite platform

Stop 119 Wells St – to Toorak: Connect with buses at a temporary stop near Stop 22 Toorak Rd, 850m/11 min walk

Stop 118 Sturt St – to West Coburg: Connect with buses in Dorcas St, 600m/ 8 min walk

Stop 118 Sturt St – to Toorak: Connect with buses at Stop 19 Shrine of Remembrance, 600m/ 8 min walk

Stop 117 York St – to West Coburg: Connect with buses in Dorcas St, 750m/10 min walk

Stop 117 York St – to Toorak: Connect with buses at Stop 19 Shrine of Remembrance, 750m/ 10 min walk

Stop 116 City Rd – both directions: Connect with buses at Stop 115 Casino/Southbank, 450m/ 6 min walk

Stop 1 Flinders St – to West Coburg: Connect with trams at a temporary stop at Flinders and Market sts, 50m/1 min walk

Stop 1 Flinders St – to Toorak: Connect with buses at a temporary stop at Flinders and Market sts, 50m/1 min walk

Alternative travel

Your journey maybe affected during these works, so plan ahead, consider alternative travel options between the city and south eastern suburbs and allow extra time.

Traffic congestion is expected, so drivers and cyclists are encouraged to avoid the area if possible.
