Saturday 23 February to Thursday 28 February, first to last tram



Buses replace Route 1 and 6 trams between Stop 120 Brunswick Road and East Coburg or Moreland, diverting around the work zone.

Friday 1 March to Thursday 7 March, first to last tram



Buses replace Route 1 trams between Stop 129 Moreland Road and East Coburg, diverting around the work zone.



Route 6 trams run as normal.
