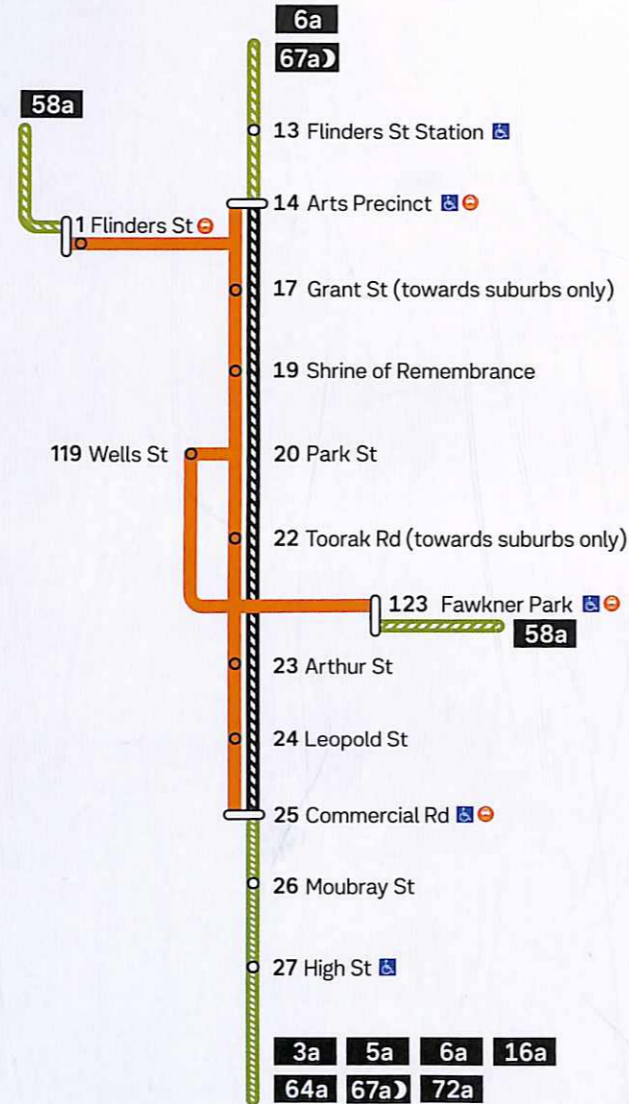

What's happening?

Buses replace trams along St Kilda Road including **Route 58**, as we continue to build the Metro Tunnel and the new Anzac Station (opening 2025).

These works include the realignment of tram tracks between Stop 20 Park St and Stop 22 Toorak Rd. The new Anzac Station tram stop will be operational at Stop 20 from 7am Saturday 17 December.

Your journey may be affected during these works, so plan ahead, consider alternative travel options and allow extra time. Traffic congestion is expected, so drivers and cyclists are encouraged to avoid the area if possible.



Pedestrians

Street closures and detours will be in place. Follow signage in the area to get around the work zone.

- Route 3, 3a, 16: Stop 38 Balaclava Station
- Route 5, 64: Stop 32 Chapel St (Windsor Station)
- Route 67: Stop 44 Elsternwick Station
- Route 6: Stop 30 Prahran Station
- Route 58: Stop 127 South Yarra Station

Cranbourne, Frankston, Pakenham line trains can be accessed from:

- Route 72: Stop 37 Toorak Station

- +** Alfred Hospital: catch a Route 72 replacement bus from Stop 14 Arts Precinct

- 🏠** Como or Toorak Village: catch a train between the city and South Yarra Station and walk
- 🍎** Prahran Market: catch a train between the city and Prahran Station and walk
