Provided that one child under the age of three years, if accompanied by a person who has paid an adult fare, shall be permitted to travel free, vide Rule No. 185.

“Adult” includes any person not under the age of 12 years.

CITY CONCESSION FARES

1½d. Tickets are sold by the Board in strips of 8 Tickets for one shilling.

Each Ticket is good for a single journey (Adult or Child) over any one of the following portions of City lines, a Special Concession Check being issued in exchange for each Ticket received:—

1½d. Tickets may be accepted in payment or part-payment of any fare of 2d. or over other than those payable by 2d. Ticket only on the Footscray Tramway Routes, change being given, if necessary.

VALUE TICKETS

2d. Tickets sold in strips of 6 tickets for 1/- are to be accepted in payment or part payment of any fare other than City Concession Fares, cash change being given when necessary.

3d. Tickets sold in strips of 8 tickets for 2/- are available for payment or part payment of any fare other than on the Footscray Tramway Routes or for City Concession Fares. With these exceptions, cash change may be given when necessary.

Barred Tickets must be accepted as above, but change must not be given therefor, check tickets to the full value of same being issued.

ROUND TRIP EXCURSION TICKETS

The fare for each continuous journey in the one direction through Melbourne, St. Kilda, Caulfield, Malvern, Hawthorn, Kew and Richmond, or vice versa, to starting point, by ticket, available from any point in the round trip—on day of issue only—by the following Electric Tramways:—

Between Town Hall, Melbourne, and St. Kilda Esplanade, by St. Kilda Beach Car, via St. Kilda Road, from the City, or City Car from the Esplanade. Journey may be broken at St. Kilda Esplanade;

Between St. Kilda Esplanade and Kew, by Cotham Road, Kew, Car from the Esplanade, or St. Kilda Beach Car from Kew;

Between Kew and Swanston Street, Melbourne, by Spencer Street Car, via Victoria Bridge and Collins Street, changing from or to St. Kilda Beach Car at Cotham Road corner.

SCHOLARS' CONCESSION FARES

Tickets are available only for a journey commenced before 6.30 p.m. Monday to Friday inclusive, and before 1 p.m. on Saturday.

Tickets are not available on Sundays nor during the school vacations; but may be used by scholars attending school on any other day.

Conditions and forms of application may be obtained at Head Office or any Depot.

CHARGES FOR EXCESS LUGGAGE

The charge to be paid by each passenger upon any TRAMWAY of the Board who shall take with him permitted personal luggage, parcels, or packages exceeding in the aggregate 28 lb., but not exceeding 56 lb. in weight, or 36 x 18 x 12 inches in dimension, shall be an additional full fare. Luggage, parcels, or packages exceeding in the aggregate 56 lb. in weight, or 36 x 18 x 12 inches in dimension, are not permitted.

Luggage, Parcels or Packages exceeding in the aggregate 28 lb. in weight are not to be carried on MOTOR OMNIBUSES.

CHARGES FOR CARRIAGE OF NEWSPAPERS

The charge to be made for parcels of Newspapers addressed to Newsagents and carried upon any TRAMWAY of the Board shall be one adult fare for each parcel separately addressed not exceeding 28 lb. in weight, and two adult fares for each parcel exceeding 28 lb., but not exceeding 56 lb. in weight. Parcels exceeding 56 lb. in weight, or 36 x 18 x 12 inches in dimension, are not to be carried.

When parcels of Newspapers are accompanied by a passenger they are to be treated as Personal Luggage.

Newspapers are not to be carried on MOTOR OMNIBUSES.

SPECIAL CARS AND BUSES

Charges and conditions of hire may be obtained on application at Head Office.

MINIMUM CHARGE UPON CERTAIN VEHICLES

Whenever indicated by notice on the vehicle, the minimum adult fare shall be as thereon specified.

CHILDREN'S CARRIAGES

Children's carriages may be carried upon any Tramway, providing that there is room for them in the platforms, gangways, or saloons without incommoding passengers, and that the full adult fare is paid for each.

Children's carriages are not to be carried on Motor Omnibuses.

HALFPENNY FARES FOR DENTAL CENTRE SCHOLARS

Fare Concession Certificates are issued to Head Masters of all Suburban State Schools for use by teachers when travelling with scholars between their respective schools and the Dental Centre in City Road, South Melbourne.

Available only on Week Days (Saturdays and Holidays excepted) between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m.

Certificate to be produced by the teacher when paying the fares.

Fare for each scholar is ONE HALFPENNY for a single journey on any route.

This fare does not entitle the scholar to a transfer.

Teachers will pay ordinary full fare for themselves.

Tickets of large denomination to the value of total fares paid to be issued to the teacher. In cases where an odd halfpenny is involved, tickets to the value of the next higher penny are to be issued and a refund applied for.

Note to be made on Journal of number of scholars carried on these concession fares. No. of certificate to be quoted in each case.

SWIMMING CLASS TICKETS

During the Summer Season (1st November to 30th April, inclusive), these tickets are to be accepted from State School Children, under 16 years of age, attending Swimming Classes in squads of not less than 5. Each ticket will represent a fare for one child for a single journey on any route between the School named thereon and the Baths attended.

Tickets are only available on week days, Monday to Friday inclusive for a journey commenced between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Not good for use on any Public Holidays, or between 19th December and 2nd January, inclusive.

Not available for Transfer.

In some instances these Tickets are made available in the Winter months (see Local Notices)

SPECIAL CONCESSION CERTIFICATES FOR USE OF STATE SCHOOL SCHOLARS

Special Concession Certificates are issued to State School Scholars, aged between 12 and 16 years, for use when travelling to and from Central Schools for special instruction.

The Certificates entitle the children whose names are endorsed thereon to travel at Children's Ordinary Fares on the following conditions:—

Not transferable and must only be used when travelling between the schools endorsed thereon.

Not available—(a) in the Smoking Compartments of the car, or (b) on Saturdays, Sundays, or school holidays, or (c) later than 4.30 p.m. on other week days.

Must be shown to the Conductor when fare is paid and on demand by authorised officer.

Certificates of a different colour will be issued for each half-year.

POST OFFICE EMPLOYEES' TICKETS.

These tickets are to be accepted from Letter Carriers and Telegraph Messengers on duty (if permanent men, when wearing their full uniform, or, if casual men, when wearing a Red Arm Badge lettered "P.M.G." in black) as payment of a two section fare on any day (Sundays and Holidays included). A 2d. Ticket (plain) correctly punched must be issued for each such ticket received.

The paragraph on Page 38 dealing with Charges for Excess Luggage is also applicable to parcels, bags, or other mail matter carried by such P.O. Employees.

POLICE CONCESSION TICKETS

These Tickets are to be accepted from members of the Police Force (in plain clothes) as payment for a through journey on any one Route, (but are not available for Transfer).

A 2d. Ticket (plain) correctly punched, must be issued in exchange for each such ticket received.

Members of the Police Force in uniform are to be permitted to travel free.

SPECIAL 2d. AND 3d. TICKETS (BARRED)

These Tickets are to be accepted for journeys by the most direct route between any point in the Metropolis and the following Hospitals:—*Royal Melbourne, Children's, Women's, Eye and Ear, Prince Henry's, Queen Victoria, St. Vincent's, Alfred.*

Tickets are available only for a journey commenced between the hours of 9.0 a.m. and 4.30 p.m., Monday to Friday inclusive.

Check Tickets to the full face value of the Special Tickets received, and punched in the usual way, are to be issued.

Under no circumstances is change to be given.

CONCESSION FARES FOR VISITING NURSES

Visiting Nurses of the Melbourne District Nursing Society, and Visiting Sisters of "The Little Company of Our Lady", when in uniform and on presentation of current Fare Concession Certificates, are entitled to travel over any of the Board's Routes on payment of Children's Fares.

CONCESSION FARES FOR SCOUTS, ETC.

Boy Scouts and Girl Guides in full uniform are permitted to travel at Children's fares, irrespective of age. This does not apply to adult officers.

The uniforms worn are as follows:—

Boy Scouts—"Baden Powell" hats; shirts in khaki, blue or green; dark knickers and puttees or stockings; scout badge worn on left breast pocket; scout belt.

Wolf Cubs—Green cap with gold edgings; jersey in green or blue; scarf or neckerchief; wolf cub badge on left breast.

Sea Scouts—White sailor cap; jersey in blue with words "Sea Scouts" written across; scout badge on left breast; scout belt and scarf.

Girl Guides—Navy blue dress with leather belt; "G.G." on shamrock-shaped badge; coloured tie, according to company; black shoes and stockings; and with or without navy blue felt hat.

SUNDAY MORNING SERVICES

Ordinary fares are chargeable on all cars, other than "All-Night" cars, providing Sunday morning services.

FAMILY EXCURSION TICKETS

Family Excursion Tickets are available on Sunday morning cars on the following conditions:—

Each Ticket shall entitle 2 adults and 4 children under 14 years of age, or 1 adult and 5 children under 14 years of age, to travel between the points indicated on the Ticket.

The Ticket is not available to adults unless accompanied by at least 1 child under 14 years of age, nor to children under 14 years of age not accompanied by at least 1 adult.

The forward journey must be commenced before 12.0 noon on the day of issue.

The Tickets are available only by the most direct route between the points indicated thereon, and must be shown on demand or the ordinary scale of fares paid.

ALL-NIGHT SERVICES

With the following exceptions, the fare to be charged for each passenger, *adult or child*, on any car providing All-Night services shall be on the basis of:—

One or Two Sections	4d.
More than Two Sections	8d.

EXCEPTIONS: Between Victoria Street, City, and Luna Park, St. Kilda (via St. Kilda Road) ..	6d.
Between Victoria Street, City, and Fitzroy St., St. Kilda (via South Melbourne)	6d.

EMPLOYEES travelling to or from duty are to be permitted to ride free under the usual conditions.

POLICE in uniform are to be permitted to ride free, but Police Concession Tickets are not available.

PASSES held by Members of Parliament are to be recognised, but all other Passes and Concessions are to be refused and full fares charged.

TOURIST TRIPS

Tourist Trips are conducted daily, and particulars regarding routes and bookings can be obtained from Head Office or Batman Avenue Shelter.
