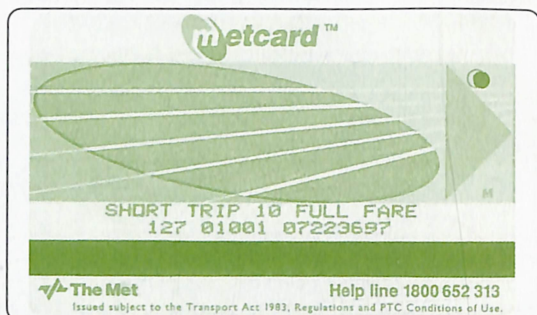

With Yarra Trams' new Short Trip in Zone 1, you can travel up to two sections more easily and economically than ever before.

Available for full fare or concessions, these tickets are the cost effective way to take a short trip to the shops, the doctor or even to visit a friend. And of course they are ideal for travel within the City.

They are available for continuous journeys of up to two sections (boarding section plus adjacent section) and can even be purchased as a 10 trip ticket for added convenience at retail outlets. Full fare and concession single short trip tickets are available on board trams – short trip tickets purchased on board the tram are already validated. (Tickets are not transferable)

HOW THEY WORK

This booklet is designed to make you, our valued customer, aware of the location of the sections. The main aim is to assist you in establishing whether your journey can be completed within the two section limit. To find out if a Short Trip Ticket is best for your trip, follow these simple steps:

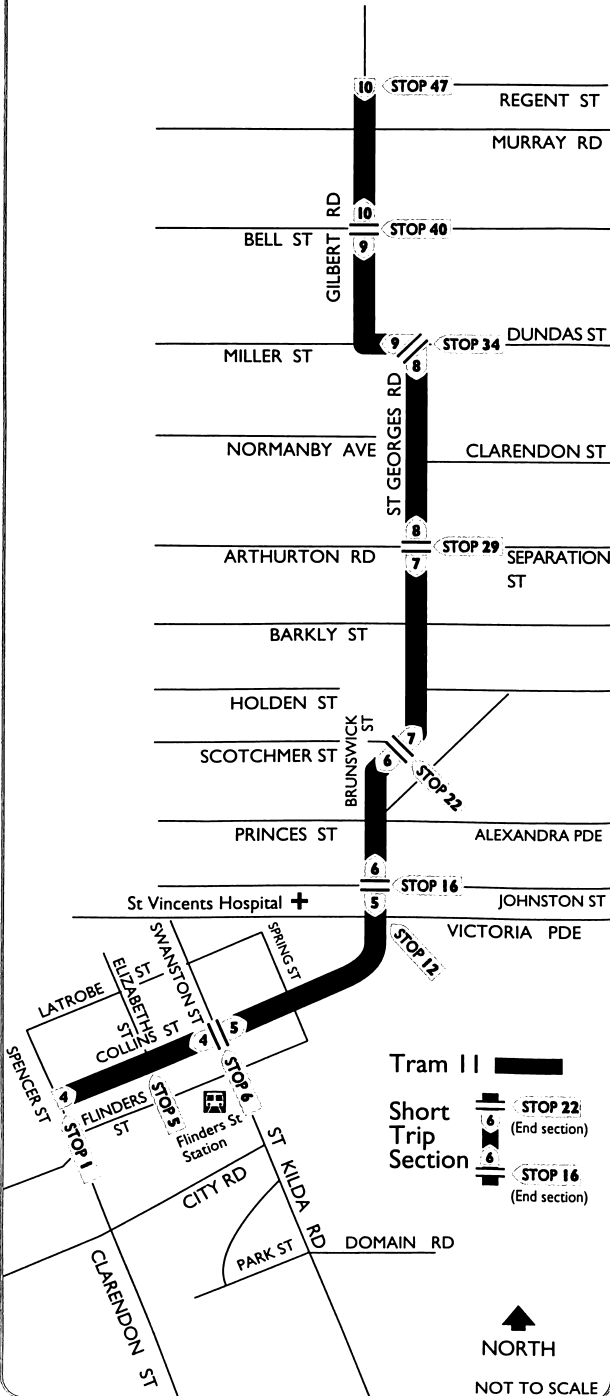
- 1 Find the tram route that you wish to travel on (refer to table of contents).
- 2 Find your starting point. The map will show you major streets, stop numbers and landmarks.
- 3 Find your destination.
- 4 Count the numbers of sections that you are travelling through including the section where you will begin your journey.



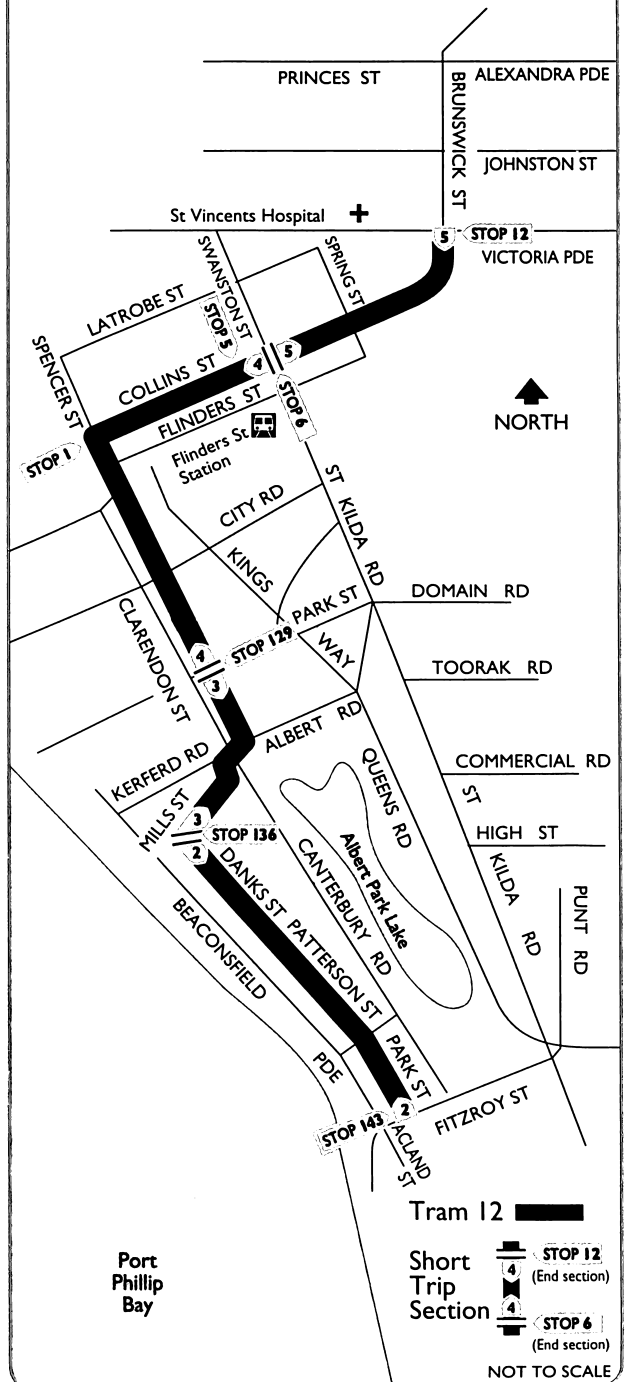
If your destination is within two sections, then a Short Trip Ticket is your best option. When you board your tram your ticket will be marked with the location you boarded and show your direction of travel.

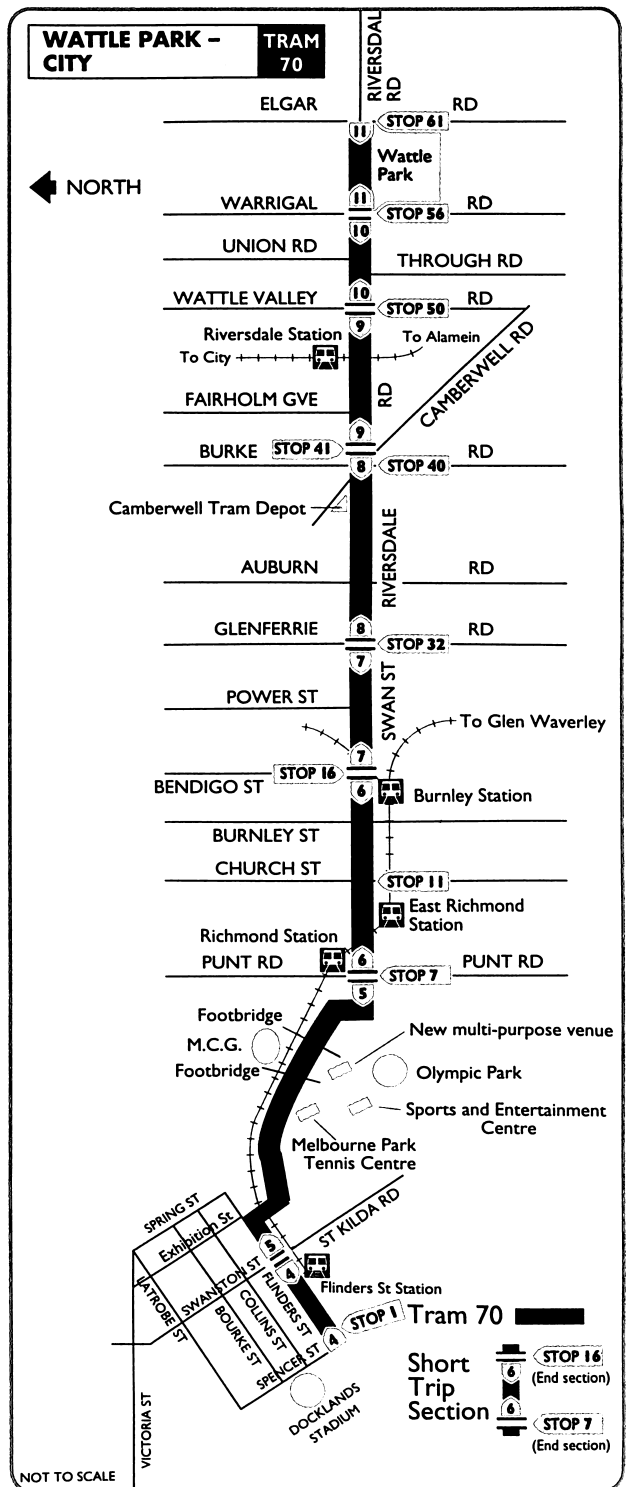
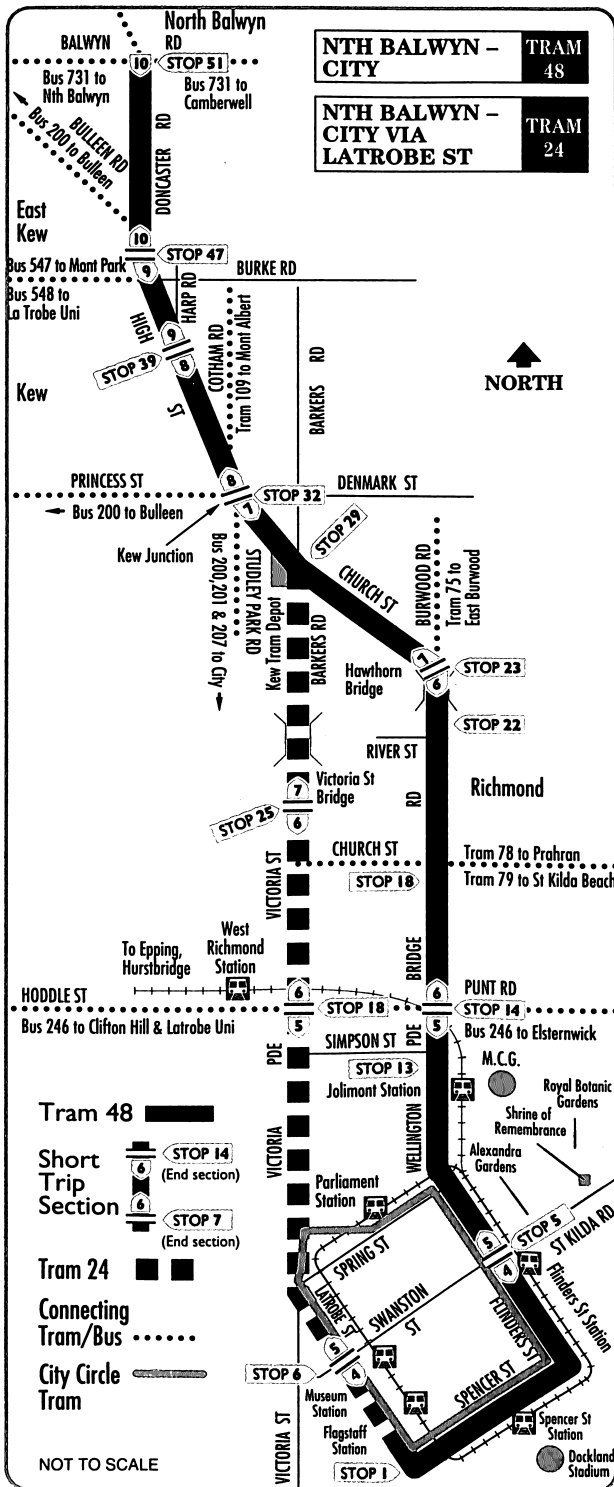

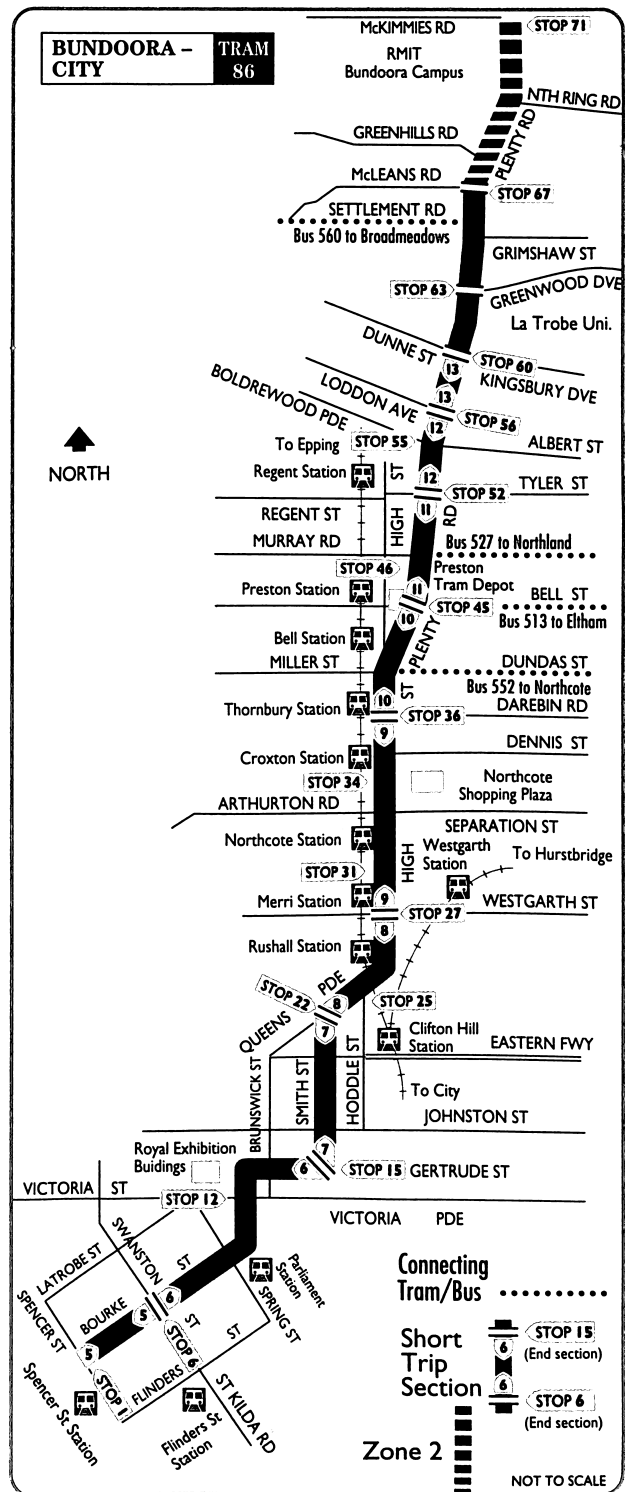
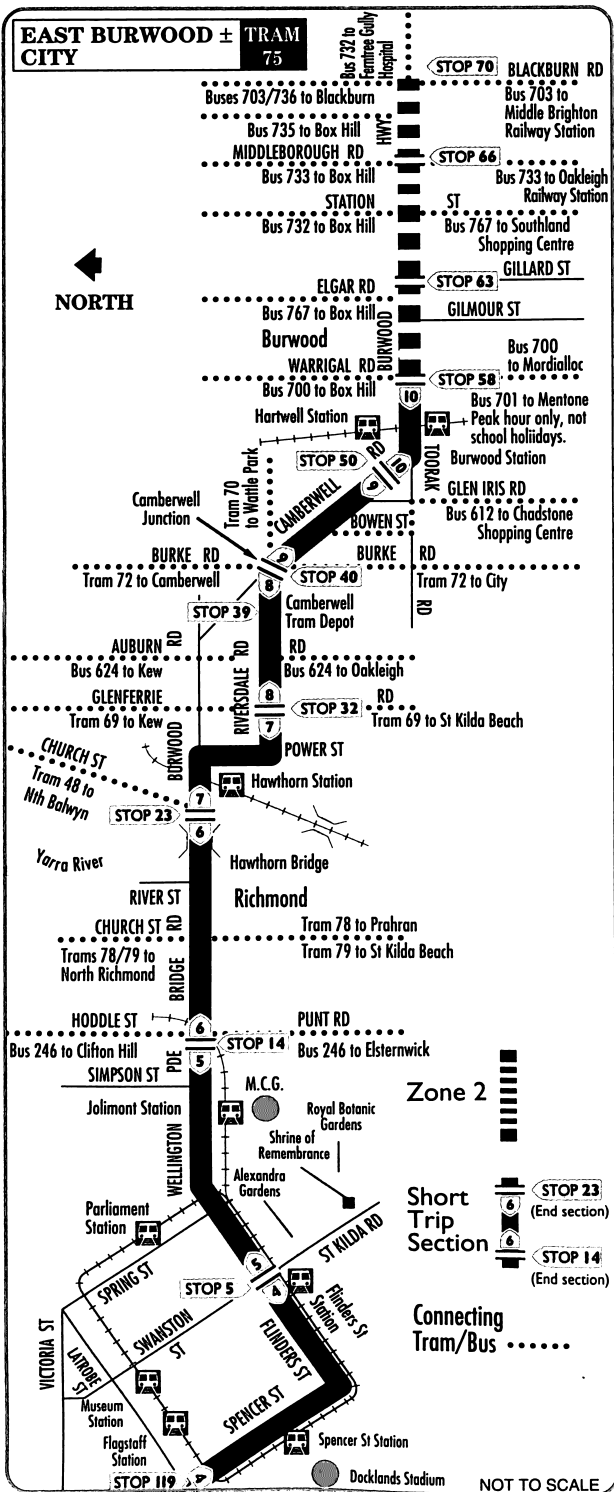
WEST PRESTON - TRAM II



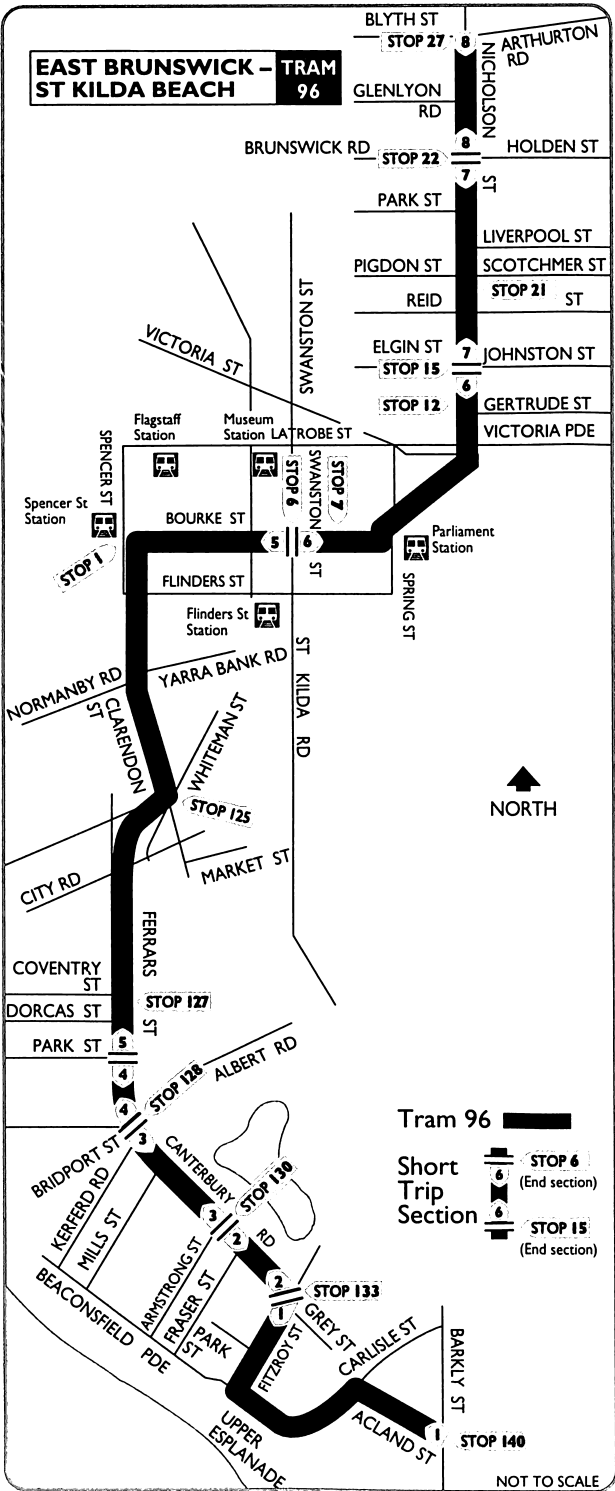
SOUTH MELBOURNE & ST KILDA BEACH - CITY TRAM 12
